### FLYING SAUCERS ARE REAL

As part of the SMUSA Lecture series, Nuclear Physicist - Lecturer Stanton T. Friedman will present an illustrated lecture: "Flying Saucers ARE Real".

*This lecture was originally scheduled in November but due to a severe snow storm then, it will now be held on January 13th.*

Friedman, full-time lecturer on controversial scientific subjects, has spoken at more than 500 colleges and dozens of professional groups in 48 states and 8 Canadian provinces. Overflow crowds, extended questions and answer sessions, and favorable, often front page, newspaper coverage have been the rule rather than the exception. He has appeared on hundreds of TV and Radio programs including Merv Griffin, Mike Douglas, Canada AM, PBS Late Night and many others. Since moving to Fredericton from California in 1980, he has done a weekly science commentary for CBC radio. He is well known for communicating in terms everyone can understand, with lots of humour.

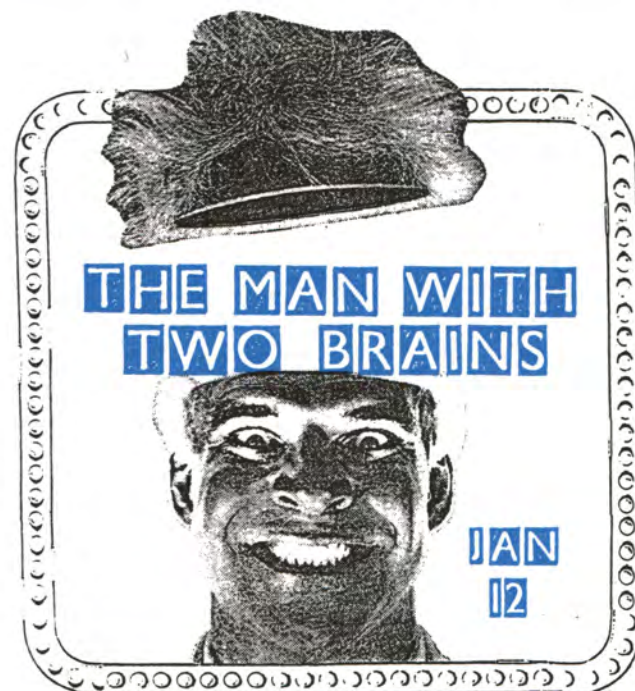
