- 1) **Postage stamps:** they are now readily and easily available from the SMUSA Information Desk in the Student Centre. The stamps are available seven days a week and there are no empty machines to deal with.
- 2) **Photocopying:** available in the lobby of the Student Centre next to the Info Desk. A high quality machine has been installed to provide crisp, clear copies for ten cents each. The machine also has the added feature of being able to enlarge or reduce your original and copy transparencies. No need to fuss with change either, just walk up and get the key to the machine from the SMUSA Desk Attendant and pay when your finished. Its easy and there is no maddening line up.
- 3) **Typing Service:** Starting in mid-September you will no longer have to search for someone to type your term papers, resumes, etc. Drop your work off at the SMUSA Info Desk and a qualified typist will type your paperr in record time and then return it to you. Check the rates, there very reasonable also.
