- .01 Academic Planning Committee MPHEC Proposal from the Faculty of Arts for program modification of the B.A. Degree to include a Co-op option circulated as *Appendix B* Key Discussion Points:
 - Discussion covered student placements. Placements are identified through the efforts of faculty, students and the Co-op Office. A suggestion was made to provide an estimate in the proposal of the expected enrolments versus the historical data on placements.
