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DEFINITIONS

1. Full-Time Students (FTS)

A full-time student is one whose primary occupation is personal attendance at the University and who is enrolled in the equivalent of three or more full courses during the regular academic year. (September to May).

2. Part-Time Students (PTS)

A student registered in a degree program at Saint Mary's University but enrolled in less than the equivalent of three full courses during the regular academic year.

3. Special Student (SPE)

A student, working towards a degree at another academic institution, who has a letter of permission to take a course or courses at Saint Mary's University.

4. UPGRADING STUDENT (UPG)

A student who already holds an undergraduate degree or professional certificate and who wishes to take additional credit courses at Saint Mary's University.

5. NON-DEGREE PROGRAMME STUDENT (NDP)

A status permitting a student to take a course or courses although that individual has not been accepted in a degree programme at Saint Mary's University.

6. Course Registration

One student enrolled in one-full course.

7. Average Section Size

Number of course registrations in a department or faculty divided by the number of course sections in the department or faculty.

8. Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Faculty

The number of full-time faculty plus the full-time equivalent of part-time faculty. As a general rule, a part-time faculty member is considered as one-third (1/3) full-time equivalent for each full-year course he teaches.

9. Course Registrations per Full-Time Equivalent Faculty

Course registrations per FTE Faculty are calculated by dividing the course registrations by the number of FTE faculty.

10. Student to Faculty Ratio

This is calculated by dividing the course registrations by five (5) and by the number of FTE Faculty.

NOTE: All statistics based on December 1, 1978, unless otherwise stated.
