- Upgrading Student:** student who already holds an undergraduate degree or professional certificate who is taking additional courses at Saint Mary's.
- Non-degree Student:** student taking a course or courses who has not been accepted into a degree programme at Saint Mary's.
- Course registration:** one course registration is equivalent to one student enrolled in one full-unit course.
