10050 REPORT OF THE AGENDA COMMITTEE

10051 SAINT MARY'S UNIVERSITY 2011-2012 OPERATING BUDGET

The University Budget presentation was given by Larry Corrigan. Key Points:

- The Capital Budget is \$4 million. The Operating Budget is \$107 million. Budget details are available in the Senate Office.
- Questions: It was noted that the capital project list did not include a new arena. There is currently a \$4 million set-aside for this purpose. Consultation had identified \$16 million as the replacement cost. The ice plant has been replaced.
- Question. How many of those eligible to retire chose not to? Answer: Nine chose to remain of the 10 we projected in our budget. The legislation requires the government to cover any amount incurred in this area if it can be shown to be substantial. Currently this situation costs the University \$400,000 a year, but that figure will increase. We project an approximate worst case cost to the University of 1 million a year. We have asked the minister for compensation because of the impact.

- The University Budget Committee consulted directly with individual units to generate the university budget. The deans discussed individual areas and decided how to implement changes. All units had input to the Budget Committee and that process worked well this year. A suggestion was that all areas for consideration get early direction in regard to the process and are informed at that time that the Committee requires detailed analysis and information to be provided this year.
- Members were advised that the Government wants to readdress the funding formula.

Key Discussion Points:

There has been no progress on the MOU process since the last Senate meeting.

- The university presidents were advised that discussions would commence at the beginning of April. That has not happened.
- One significant individual on the government committee is retiring and that will represent a loss of institutional memory in regard to the process.
- We anticipate there will be more cuts in the future. Including Dr. Dodds, there are three university presidents on the negotiating committee.
- Cuts will be necessary within the university.
