1. Full-Time Students (FTS)

A full-time student is one whose primary occupation is personal attendance at the University and who is enrolled in the equivalent of three or more full courses during the regular academic year. (September to May).

2. Part-Time Student (PTS)

A student registered in a degree program at Saint Mary's University but enrolled in less than the equivalent of three full courses during the regular academic year.

3. Special Student

A student registered in a degree program at a university other than Saint Mary's University or a student with a first degree not registered in a degree program at any university but enrolled in a credit course at the University during the regular academic year.

4. Course Registration

One student enrolled in one-full course.

5. Average Section Size

Number of course registrations in a department of faculty divided by the number of course sections in the department or faculty.

6. Full-Time Equivalent Faculty

The number of full-time faculty plus the full-time equivalent of part-time faculty. As a general rule, a part-time faculty member is considered as one-third (1/3) full-time equivalent for each full-year course he teaches.

7. Pass Rate and Grade Point Average

The following formula was used:

$$\text{pass rate} = \frac{\text{No. of A, B+, B, C+, C, C-, D}}{\text{No. of A, B+, B, C+, C, C-, D, F, WF}} \times 100$$

for computing grade point average (GPA); A=4, B+=3.5, B=3.0, C+=2.5, C=2.0, C-=1.5, D=1.0, F=0.0, WF=0.0. Any other mark was excluded in the calculation.

NOTE: All statistics based on December 1 unless otherwise stated.
