

CAMPUS ORGANIZATIONS

STUDENTS REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL

The Student Council is the representative voice of the students on Campus. It comprises of 14 people which include an executive, internal, external, cultural affairs plus your faculty represen-

They usually represent the students on committees, make appointments to administrative positions, handle all of the Association's vast wealth, etc. The Council meets at least twice a month and meeting times are placed on bulletin boards in the SUB. All students are permitted to attend these meetings which are held in the fourth floor Board Room SUB.

Elections for the SRC usually are held in February and all students are eligible to run for office.

THE JOURNAL

The Journal is the Student Newspaper here at Saint Mary's. It usually appears on a weekly basis and is representative of the students' views on specific happenings around Saint Mary's. This year's Journal Editor is Paulene Vaughan, who will entertain any ideas, critisms, etc., and will endeavour to uncover the roots and factual information concerning any problem on Campus.

NEED FOR AN ON-CAMPUS MANPOWER CENTRE

The most significant and most inescapable fact facing both undergraduates and graduates of post-secondary institutions is that they must now truly compete for their jobs. The pressing need for hundreds of uncommitted graduates who possess a B.A. or a B.Sc. and who have no definite occupational goal is to talk to someone the can provide useful employment information, sound educational and occupational and occupa who can provide useful employment information, sound educational and occupational counselling and up-to-date labour market information. In essence, to help them to market their skills and latent aptitudes. This is Canada Manpower's concern in association with universities.

Specialized demand exists for those going into the professions, such as: medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, law, accountancy, commerce, economics, computer science, geology, biology, social sciences, pollution environmental science, and a few more such as community planners, and technicians and selected occupations in the developing health manpower field. But even these occupations are now increasingly subject to budgetary limitations and economic contingencies. Times are definitely changing and the labour market trend on the Atlantic campus and accross the Canadian campus has switched on one which reflects more students and less demand. The boom years of the sixties, when students were in popular demand and our on-campus offices served largely as meeting centres for swarming recruiters are now becoming centres of concern and require a new

swarming recruiters are now becoming centres of concern and require a new direction oriented toward Counselling Resource Centres.

Students, universities, Institutes of Technology, employers, the general public collectively will require that we take a positive stand and set our directional tone and long range course for the Seventies and Eighties. In final analysis, what matters is that the students get the required service, be it through an agency of the matters is that the students get the required service, be it through an agency of the Federal Government, through the university itself, by means of the private sector or through a combination of factors.

> HISTORY OF ON-CAMPUS MANPOWER CENTRES

In the Atlantic Region, it traces its roots from the pressing need to assist Second World War Veterans who flocked in the thousands to universities following cessation of hostilities in 1945. Initially, a part-time registration was provided and efforts were made to get students short-term employment at Christmas and during the summer as well as helping students make contacts with employers. Many (veteran) students were coping with family and economic problems as well.

Veterans organizations and universities were pleased with these employment efforts and resultant new practice in the job placement field.

TRENDS IN COUNSELLING

In a shrinking labour market where new graduates of general courses are no there is a proof to post in a proof to post in the course on the course of the post in the course of the post in the course of the post in the course of the course of the post in the course of the post in the course of the cou longer being considered by employers, there is a need to rethink our role on the campus. More emphasis must be placed on preparing students to graduate with marketable skills — this means occupational counselling at its most productive — "the process of assisting an inexperienced applicant who has not made a satisfactory vocational choice to review and evaluate his present and potential qualifications and relate them to occupational requirements so that he may solve qualifications and relate them to occupational requirements so that he may select an appropriate occupation and develop a realistic vocational plan." This is a process which cannot happen in a final year of graduation. It must essentially begin at the Freshman level and carry on through to graduation. It consists in begin at the Freshman level and carry on through to graduation. It consists in providing realistic, up-to-date, easily accessible occupational and labour market information, it could mean students working in groups to arrive at an understanding of what they can hope to contribute to and get back from the labour market. It may mean UCMC personnel going into the classrooms regularly and interpreting to the various faculties the realities of the world of work. If we project cursolves into the not too distant future it is not inconceivable to consider that ourselves into the not too distant future it is not inconceivable to consider that

orientation to the labour market could eventually become an integrated component of a student's curriculum of studies. Several suggestions come to mind, for example, manpower personnel may in seminar fashion be penetrating the classroom atmosphere on the campus. In any event it would seem that dynamism is what we will look for and it will be incumbent on UCMC Managers to aggressively address themselves to the objective of providing all of the manpower services possible to university students.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Through the dissemination of labour market information and by means of the counselling process and programs (available and applicable) we attempt to help the students come to decisions which will make the best use of their knowledge

(and skills) capabilities and needs.

The staffing needs of our employer clients are met by referring to them, either on or off campus, candidates which most closely meet the requirements specified. In addition, employer needs for information concerning personnel supply and other related data, is met using our own personal knowledge, as well as departmental and extra-departmental resources.

Not as an after thought, but separate from our permanent placement role, we attempt to meet the needs of Undergraduates for part-time and summer employment. Although much is being done in co-operation with the regular CMC offices, the students and administration of the University look to the U-CMC's on their campus as being responsible for this necessary service.

SERVICE TO THE STUDENT

Ideally, I hope that our Manpower Centre becomes such a part of the students' lives that they turn to it automatically for guidence on problems of employment and career planning.

Since many students pay their way through university, summer employment and part-time jobs are very important to them. In this respect, the U-CMC must help them by staying continuously in touch with employers and jobs in co-operation with the local Canada Manpower Centre.

Though it should be evident that the major emphasis in any successful placement organization is in the student-employer relationship, the third area of responsibility, that to the university cannot be overlooked. The U-CMC can serve its institution most effectively through the breadth of information and knowledge that it gains as a part of its effective natural operation. Professors and members of the administration staff can find the answers to the questions of academic values and

it gains as a part of its effective natural operation. Professors and members of the administration staff can find the answers to the questions of academic values and curricular needs as they relate to employers' needs and attitudes.

A constant flow of information to and from the faculty and the employers is encouraged by the U-CMC Manager. Professors are most likely to know the various students' qualifications or have detailed acquaintance with degree and subject requirements that will help employers to judge candidates fairly. On the other hand, familiarity with the employer's opportunities, products, facilities and business practices can make for a more realistic approach to mutual problems when university and employer representatives meet. when university and employer representatives meet

In conclusion, I would state our objective in the following terms:

"To facilitate the matching of the employment needs, of the students of this university, to the personnel requirements of business firms and government agencies, in ways which improve the productivity of the economy and help the individual to develop to his or her potential."






Ryans Fancy in Concert Orientation '72





ORIENTATION '73

COUNSELLING

The counselling service offers guidance, advisement and counselling without charge, to any regularly enrolled student. Counsellors with professional training are available to assist students with matters of personal, social, educational or vocational concern.

Types of Service — Counselling on an individual basis; psychological, vocational, academic and aptitude testing as required; referral through the University Department of Health Services for medical advice, assistance, treatment where required. Liaison is maintained with the major educational and social agencies in the community. More emphasis is being placed, this year, on assistance to new students requiring academic and educational assistance. How to study courses and advisement on selection of courses in cooperation with academic departments will be provided.

Occupational information is also available and close contact is maintained with the Canada Manpower Centre on campus.

Location — The offices of the counselling staff are located on the fourth floor of the student Centre building. Office hours are from 8:45 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Provision will be made for emergency calls beyond these hours.

Appointments can be made by phoning 422-7361, Local 181 or by visiting the office of the secretary in Room 413.

APPEALS

Unknown to most Students, Saint Mary's University does have a system of appealling marks if you, the student feel that your were unfairly dealt with. The committee which examines your complaints is titled: The Academic Standing Committee with Prof. Ron Connell of the Business Department of Commerce as Chairman. The committee examines all complaints and has the power to either grant new marks or uphold the marks already granted.

The committee has student representatives appointed by Senate and these reps are, who else, but Kenneth T. and Kenneth L. Langille who we have met up with before. If you have a beef about unfair treatment, write our your complaint and take it to either Ron Connell or the Langilles and they will guarantee that something will be done. However, please keep in mind that you have to have a valid reason to appeal plus you have to have evidence to back up your story.

In order to bring an appeal to the Committee, the following procedure is usually adopted:

1. Go see the Professor that gave you the low mark and discuss the situation with him, if he does not give you any satisfaction then ...

2. Go see the Dean of the faculty (you usually should see the Departmental Chairman before this step as he or she may be able to rectify the situation earlier) if you do not have any satisfaction here then ...

3. See Ron Connell or Ken T. or Ken L. Langille and discuss it with them. They will bring it to the committee which will examine the situation. And give a ruling.

All students not previously registered at Saint Mary's University during the preceding academic year are required to present a certificate of medical fitness, prior to registration, to Student Health Service, Room 128 North Wing, Administration Building. You have already been sent the appropriate form but if you have misplaced it, please request another.

WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

When a student withdraws from the University he or she must at once notify the Registrar in writing. The official date of withdrawal for purposes of adjustment and refund of tuition fees will be the date of receipt by the Registrar of such written notice.

A partial refund of tuition fees may be granted to a student who withdraws from the University for a reason approved by the proper authorities if application is made to the Business Office. Refunds of tuition fees will be according to the following scale:

REGISTRATION

Registration will take place on the dates and times set forth in the Academic Calendar. Students should follow exactly the directions for registration procedure supplied by the Office of the Registrar. No credit will be allowed for a course for which the student is not regularly registered.

Should registration prove insufficient, the University reserves the right to cancel any listed course.

At the time of registration students are required to satisfy the Business Office in regard to the payment of fees.

All students not previously registered at Saint Mary's University during the preceding academic year are required to present a certificate of medical fitness at registration.

Late Registration

Students registering on any other date than that designated in the Academic Calendar are required to pay a late registration fee.

Changes in Registration

Changes in registration are permitted only with departmental approval and only within the period indicated in the Academic Calendar.

No change of registration is permitted after the first week of instruction. This applies to full courses and half courses that begin in September and to half courses that begin in January.

Dropping of Courses

Students who drop a course without authorization of the Dean of Faculty will be given a grade of WF (Withdrawal Failure) on the University records (see page "Failures").

Courses taken at Other Institutions

Courses taken at other institutions after first registration at Saint Mary's will not be credited by the University unless the student has obtained prior, written approval of the Registrar.

Withdrawal

When a student withdraws from the University he must notify the Registrar at once; in which event this notification will be taken as the official date of withdrawal from the University.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Examination and Grades

University policy with respect to judging student performance in academic courses is designed to provide flexibility in the methods employed in evaluation, and as far as possible to permit the continuous notation of a student's progress throughout all stages of a course.

Accordingly, the method of evaluation in any course is determined by the member of the faculty responsible for the course, subject to approval by the appropriate department chairman and faculty dean. All professors must make known in writing no later than one week after the beginning of any course the precise procedures for determining and measuring progress in that course, including a statement of the number and form of examinations and assignments, and other means of evaluation.

The following letter-grade system, with quality point equivalents, is employed to indicate final evaluation for work in a course.

Attendance at all lectures, seminars, and laboratory periods of any course in which a student is registered is mandatory. A student whose attendance has been reported as unsatisfactory by the professor may be debarred from tests and examinations, or required to withdraw from a course or degree

A candidate for a degree must be of good moral character and must have given general satisfaction throughout his course.

Supplemental and Special Examinations

programme by the appropriate faculty dean.

- 1. On written recommendation of the professor responsible, a student is eligible to take a supplemental examination covering the same material as that contained in the course which he has failed.
- 2. Such a recommendation must be submitted to the Registrar's office in conjunction with the final grade; the supplemental examination is taken at the time prescribed in the University calendar.
- 3. To be eligible to write any supplemental examination for which he is recommended, a student must have no more than two final course grades of unsatisfactory (F) during the academic year in which the supplemental examination is to be taken.

- 4. Supplemental examinations are graded either P (satisfactory) or F (unsatisfactory).
- 5. Only one supplemental examination is permissible in any course.
- 6. No more than three full courses passed by supplemental examinations will be credited towards any degree or diploma.
- 7. Applications for supplemental examinations must be made to the Registrar's office no later than the date set down in the Academic Calendar.

Special examinations are written outside the time assigned for regular and supplemental examinations, and are granted rarely and only for extraordinary reasons by the Committee on Academic Standing.

Failures

A student whose work in a particular course is deemed by the professor to be so unsatisfactory as to preclude any reasonable prospect of achieving success may be asked to withdraw from the course, pending approval by the department chairman and the faculty dean. The grade indicated will be WF.

No course may be taken more than twice.

A student who withdraws voluntarily from any course at a point in the course where his formal evaluation is unsatisfactory (F) will receive a notation of WF on his record for that course. (See page 46) Dropping of Courses).

A student receiving a final evaluation of unsatisfactory (F) in a course which involves both lectures and laboratory work must repeat both parts of the course or an equivalent approved by the department concerned to receive a credit in the course.

A full-time student who in his first year fails to pass at least two courses must withdraw from the University for one year. Such a student may be re-admitted on academic probation following this one-year suspension.

A student who fails in more than 40 per cent of the year's work fails the year.

Any student who fails in two years of his work will no longer be granted permission to register for courses at the University.

Default of any formal process of evaluation in a course for medical reasons must be certified in written form and submitted to the Registrar's office within one week of the default.

Abyrotal Standing

Aegrotat permits a student to receive credit in a course under circumstances which prevent, for medical reasons or on compassionate grounds, the completion of a final formal process of evaluation. A professor may award aegrotat standing after satisfactory evidence has been supplied to cover the absence. Such evidence must be submitted to the Registrar's office no later than one week after the absence.

Academic Probation

Any student who receives an evaluation of unsatisfactory (F) in more than two courses at either mid-year or year-end will be placed on academic probation.

Any student whose academic record or progress is judged to be unsatisfactory because of poor attendance, incomplete assignments, or other reasons may be placed on academic probation. If the record continues to be unsatisfactory, the student may be requested to withdraw from the University by the dean of faculty.

Appeals

A student may appeal decisions taken on academic regulations by writing to the dean of the faculty concerned. Copies of the letter of appeal should also be sent to the chairman of the department and the professor involved. A decision on the appeal will be given by the dean after consultation with the faculty member and chairman. A student has the right to request the Senate to consider the appeal decision by making formal application to the Committee on Academic Standing.

SPECIAL PROGRAMMES

Summer School and Extension Division

Credit courses in Arts, Science and Commerce are offered at the University in Evening and Summer sessions. Students enrolling in these courses must have fulfilled the usual requirements for University entrance (see admission requirements for undergraduate and graduate students). Students must follow, as closely as possible, the normal sequence of courses required for regularly enrolled students and are expected to maintain the same standards in their studies. Programmes should be approved by the chairman of the department in which the student plans a major concentration.

Evening Division courses begin in September, at the usual time for commencement of classes, and end with the April examinations. Two summer Sessions of six weeks each are held: the first session begins in mid-May, and the second session early in July. Brochures describing the courses offered in the Evening Division and Summer Sessions are available from the Director's Office, the former by August 1st and the latter by January 31st.

ADMISSION TO ADVANCE STANDING

A full year's credit (five courses) will be given to a student registering in Arts who presents a Senior Matriculation Certificate, Nova Scotia Grade XII or equivalent, with an overall average of at least 60 percent, and no mark below 50 per cent in these subjects:

English, and four of the following: mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology, geology, history, geography, music, a language other than English, one social science, religious studies.

Effective the academic year 1972-73, one social science will be allowed from Grade XII. This may be modern world problems, political science, economics, or a comparable course accepted by the Department of Education.

2. Science and Commerce

A full year's credit (five courses) will be given to a student registering in Commerce or Science who presents a Senior Matriculation Certificate, Nova Scotia Grade XII or equivalent, with an overall average of at least 60 per cent, and no mark below 50 per cent in these subjects: English, mathematics, and three from biology, chemistry, geology, geography, history, physics, a language other than English, one social science, and religious studies.

This advance standing makes graduation with a general degree possible in three

3. Engineering

A student registering in Engineering who presents a Senior Matriculation Certificate, Nova Scotia Grade XII or equivalent, with an overall average of 65 per cent and no mark below 50 per cent in the following subjects: English, mathematics, physics, chemistry, and one other from biology, geology, history, geography, a social science, religious studies, a language other than English, will be able to complete the Engineering Diploma requirements in three years, and receive the Bachelor of Science degree.

The Diploma in Engineering admits the student without examination into any of the departments of the Nova Scotia Technical College for the final two years of a five-year programme leading to the degree of Bachelor of Engineering.

4. New Brunswick Students

Students who complete five Grade XII academic subjects, with a 60 per cent average and no mark below 50 per cent, may be offered admission to a three year ordinary or four year honours degree programme. Students entering Arts require English, and four academic subjects. Students in Science, Commerce, or Engineering require English, mathematics, and three academic subjects; those in Science and Engineering should offer two science subjects.

Students wishing to apply for admission to any faculty must have a pass mark in English, and 112 Mathematics. Those wishing to enter a three year programme in the Faculties of Commerce, Science or Engineering, must have a pass in 122 (or higher) Mathematics.

5. Overseas Students

Students from the United Kingdom, West Indies, West Africa and Hong Kong may be granted advanced standing on the presentation of G.C.E. Certificates in five subjects at the Ordinary Level of which two are English and Mathematics and in addition at least three subjects at the advanced level. The grade of marks obtained must average less than four.

6. Partial Credit: fewer than five courses (all faculties)

Partial credit (fewer than five courses) may be granted on the basis of Senior Matriculation standing under the following conditions:


- a) These credits be obtained before courses at the University are begun;
- b) The student have a mark of 60 per cent in each subject for which he is seeking advanced standing, except that a student in Science wishing to take further courses in mathematics or science must have a mark of 75 per cent in that subject.

7. Transfer Students


Advanced standing for work done at other Universities will be considered on the basis of individual course.

Courses taken at other institutions after first registration at Saint Mary's will not be credited by the University unless the student has obtained prior, written approval of the Registrar.
