Matt Anderson's secret to-do list

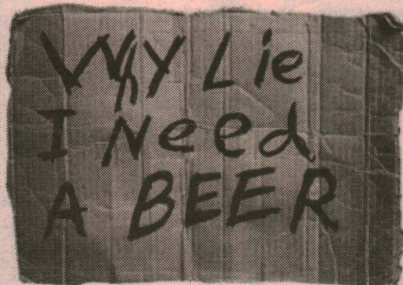

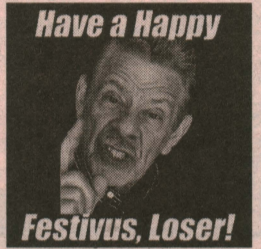
Thur, April 2nd:

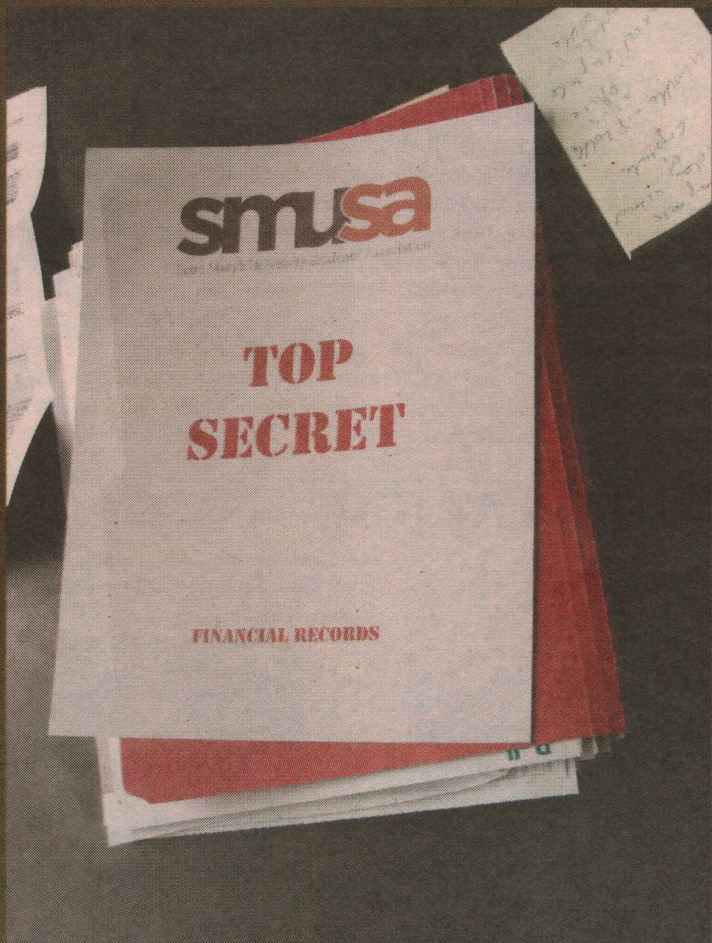

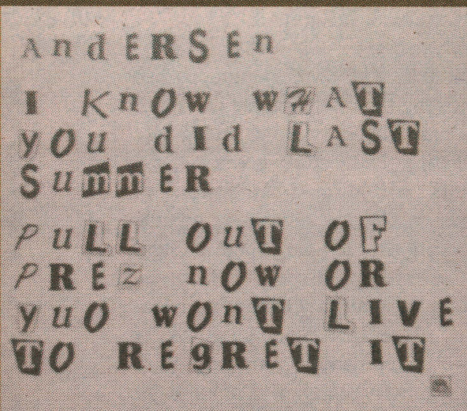

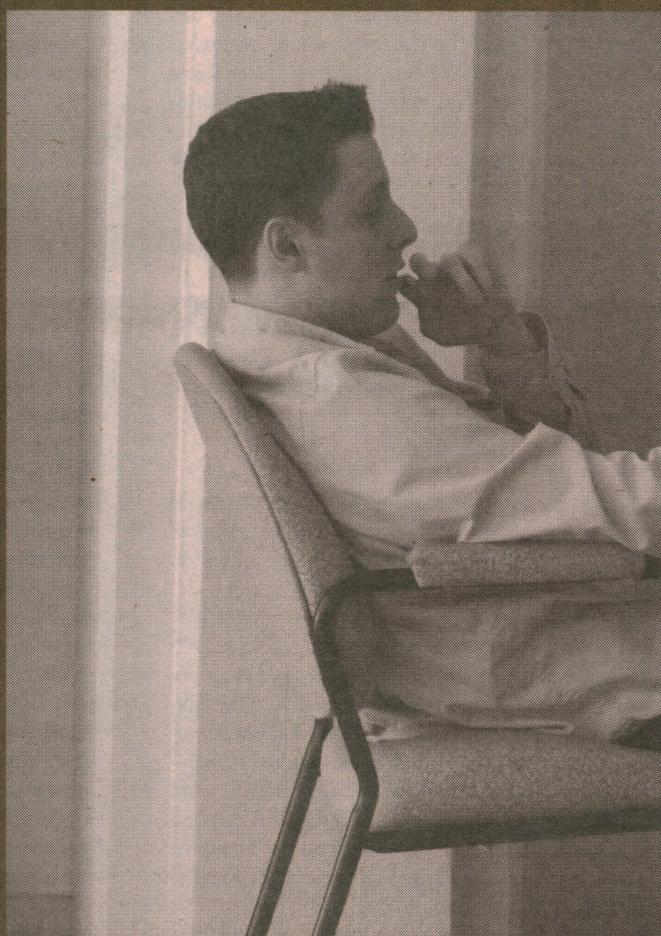
That's when we found it! After snooping around the SMUSA accounting office looking for information about where all the society funding went, we found a Top Secret account dedicated to card stock and photo finishing.

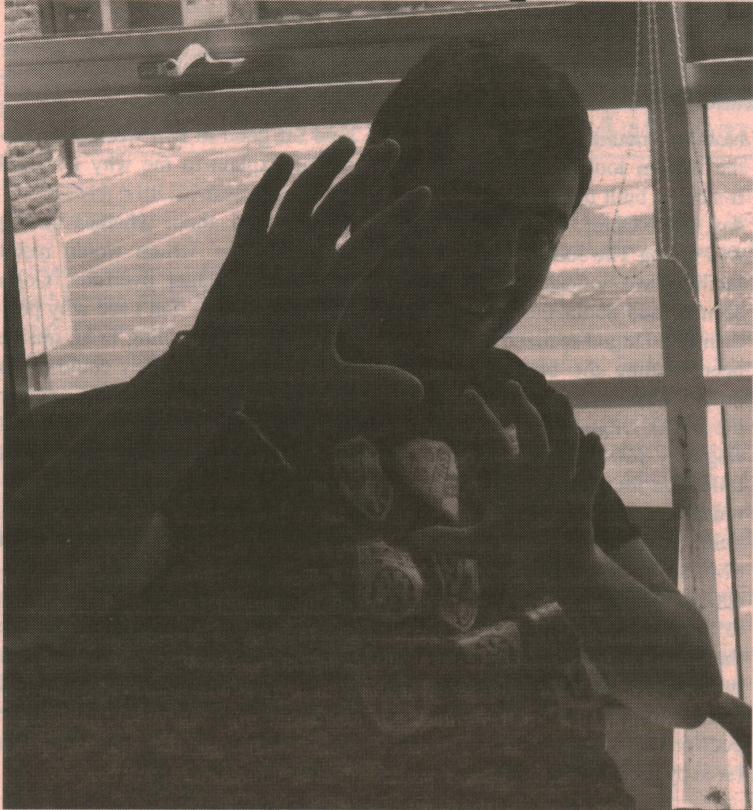
Rumour has it Matt Anderson is also outlawed from the university.

As soon as the increase happened the Restaurant Association of Nova Scotia sent out a press release

condemning NSLC for increasing the economic burden on them (for real.)

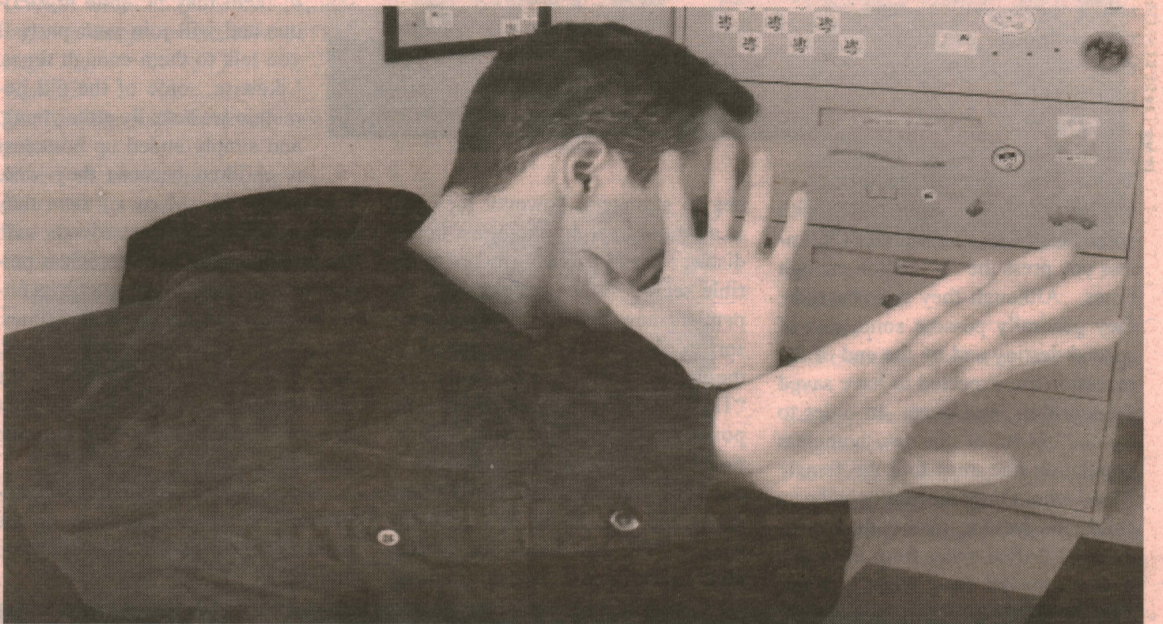
"It is disappointing that the government would not only allow, but sanction this kind of blow to an industry sector during such a tough economic time, at a point where businesses and employees are all ready suffering," said Gordon Stewart, Executive Director of RANS. "Layoffs are happening across the country due to our current tough economic times, and these increases will mean more problems for local restaurants. By failing to address changes in our economic climate by revising their budget, the province is sending the wrong message to small businesses." Indeed Mr. Stewart, at an average increase of 74 cents per product, how will you ever manage to survive?

RANS expresses concerns that the price increase could cause them to

lose even more customers than they already will due to the recession, such as Joe "I can afford this as long as it doesn't increase in price by over 73 cents" MacDonald. RANS notes that tourism is a large industry in Nova Scotia that could be affected by the price increases. After all, if there's one group that's going to reject a not-quite-three-quarters increase in bottle prices, it's the cruise-ship crowd.

Please, if you're thinking of ending it all due to this price increase, go seek help. 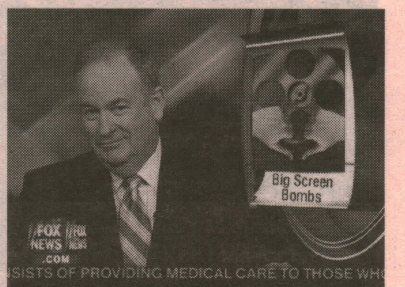

### 北朝鮮の「衛星」打ち上げは軍事目的 米国防長官発言

(CNN) ゲーツ米国防長官は29日、FOXニュースに対して、北朝鮮が「大衛星」名目で来月4-8日に予定しているロケット打ち上げは軍事力強化が狙いだと言った。

ゲーツ長官によると、米政府高官レベルは、北朝鮮のロケット打ち上げが北朝鮮が大陸間弾道ミサイル開発の隠れみであるとの認識。米軍はこうしたミサイルへの核弾頭搭載が、北朝鮮の長期的目標だと見ている。ただし同長官は、現時点で北朝鮮にその能力があるかは「個人的に疑問」とコメントした。

ゲーツ長官はまた、北朝鮮が今後ハイもしくは米西部に到達するミサイルを開発した場合、米軍がミサイル迎撃態勢を整える可能性をにじませた。ただし同長官は「現時点でそうした計画はない」と思う。同長官は、現在の北朝鮮の軍事技術ではアラスカや太平洋沿岸まで到達するミサイルの開発は不可能との見解を表明した。

ゲーツ長官はさらに、近いとされる北朝鮮のミサイル発射が、北朝鮮核問題をめぐる6者協議の行き詰まりを示しているのは明らかだと指摘。もし(ミサイル発射が)金正日総書記からオバマ米大統領への就任後なら、外交面でどのような提案をしても北朝鮮政権には通用しないということも強調に物語る」と語った。

米科学国際安全保障研究所 (ISIS) はこの日、北朝鮮の舞水端里にあるミサイル基地の衛星写真

を公表した。写真には、来月打ち上げ予定のロケットとみられる機体が舞水端里にとらえられている。

報道ステーション: 「朝野を揺るがす」SPDが認定

(Mainichi) 放送倫理・番組向上機構 (BPO) の放送と人権等権利に関する委員会 (放送人権委、委員長・竹田修平) は30日、徳島県の上地改良区協議会事件を伝えた昨年7月23日のテレビ朝日系「報道ステーション」で、重大な放送倫理違反があったと認定。決定内容を放送するようテレビ朝日に通告した。「放送倫理違反」で「見解」より重い「勧告」を出したのは05年、愛知県の産婦人科医への行政指導を報じたNHK名古屋放送局のローカルニュースに次いで2回目。



問題とされたのは、徳島県の上地改良区協議会事件を伝えた際、全国土地改良事業団体連合会 (全土連) の会長を務める野中弘治元自民党幹事長の映像を扱い、そのあと評論家が「政治力で新たな事業を改良区に与えている」と発言した点など。放送後、野中氏は放送人権委に「事件と全土連が関係があるのか」と作問的な質問がなされた」と申し立てていた。

放送人権委は、放送内容は事実と信じる相当な理由があったとして野中氏の名誉毀損は否定。一方で映像は「一部の視聴者に、あたかも専ら(野中氏)が政治力で膨らみつつある」ともいえる事業を持つてきたという認識を生じさせた」とし、安易、短絡的と批判した。さらに古澤伊知郎キャスターが「(補助金が) じゃぶじゃぶ使われているから」と発言した点も「裏付け取材の範囲を超えている」と判断した。

野中氏は「今回の通告は大きな意義がある」と評価。

テレビ朝日は「通告を真摯(しんしん)に受け止め、放送倫理や人権に十分配慮してまいります」とコメント。30日の同番組内でも古澤キャスターが同様の発言をした。【佐々木 晶子】

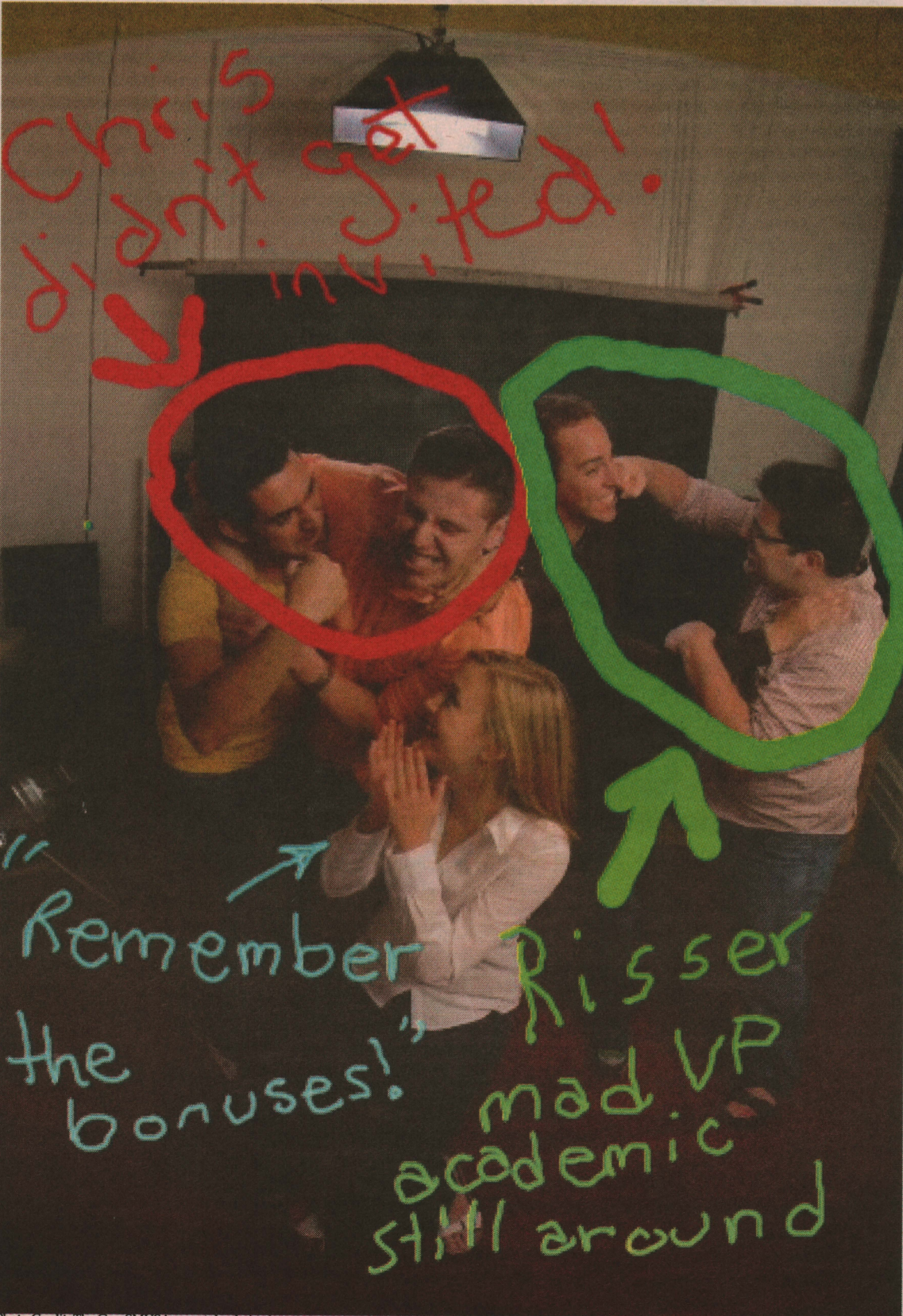

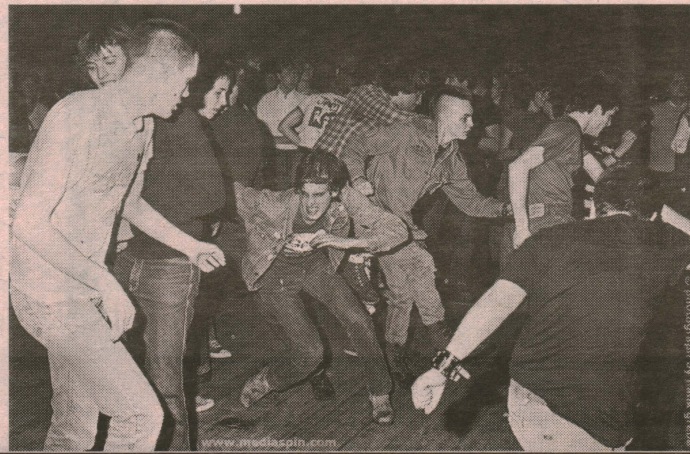
May 16, 2007: Wembley Arena, London, Britain. I showed up early in order to get a decent spot on the floor, but the line was already around the block 3 hours before doors were

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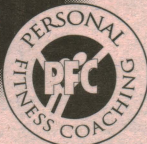
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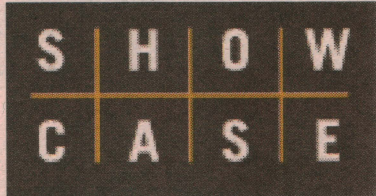
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# SMU AND SHOWCASE MAKE A PORNO

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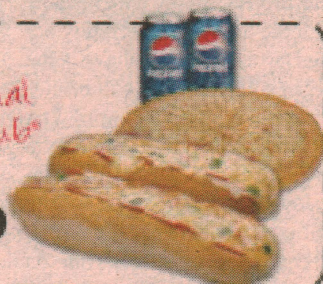


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## SURGEONS SAY MORE AND MORE MEN ARE GETTING TEAR REMOVAL SURGERY

## NEW ADDITION TO HUSKIES COACHING STAFF

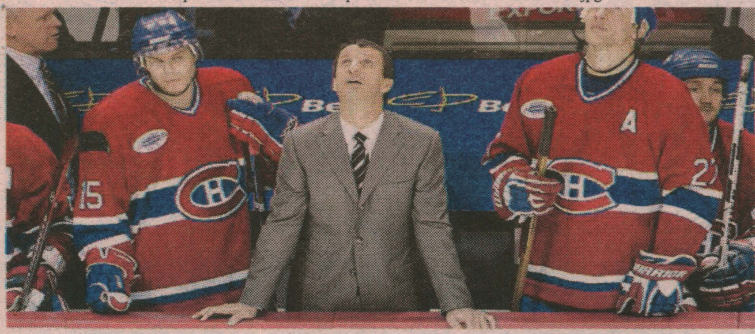
