About Our Crest

The present University crest was designed in the 1940's by Daniel Fogarty, S.J. Each symbol within the crest has a significance relevant to the various phases and history of the University.

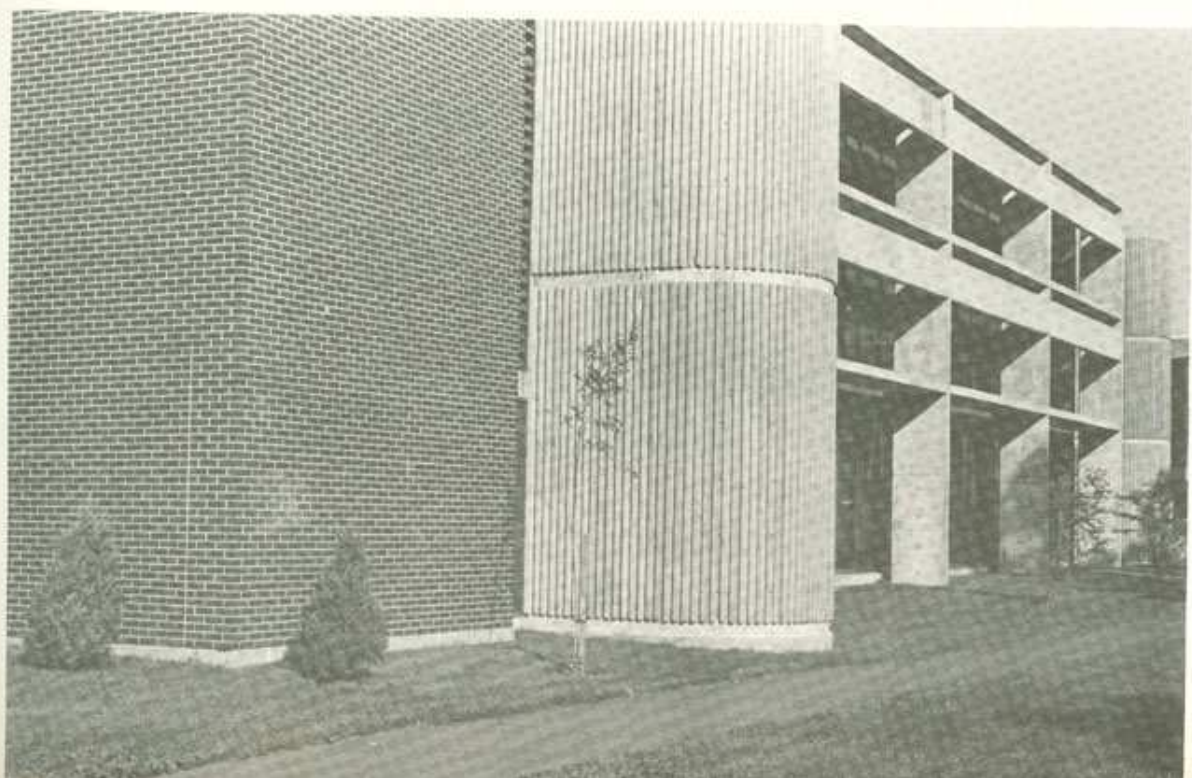
On the outer portion of the crest the name and location of the University are inscribed in Latin and the founding date (1841) in Roman numerals. This part is added for the official seal.

The book shown above the shield represents learning and knowledge. The inscription on the page of the book is in Latin — "Age Quod Agis". This is the motto of

the University which exhorts all those connected with the University to strive to do their best in everything that they do. This quotation was borrowed from the Irish Christian Brothers and represents their contribution to the development of the University.

The upper part of the shield has the official seal of the Jesuits with I.H.S. being the Latin initials for Christ's name. Below these initials are the three nails which represent the Crucifixion and surrounding these is the Crown of Thorns.

The two crowns represent a dual loyalty — to the then Dominion of Canada and to the British Commonwealth. Below these crowns is the thistle, which stands for Nova Scotia's Scottish origin.

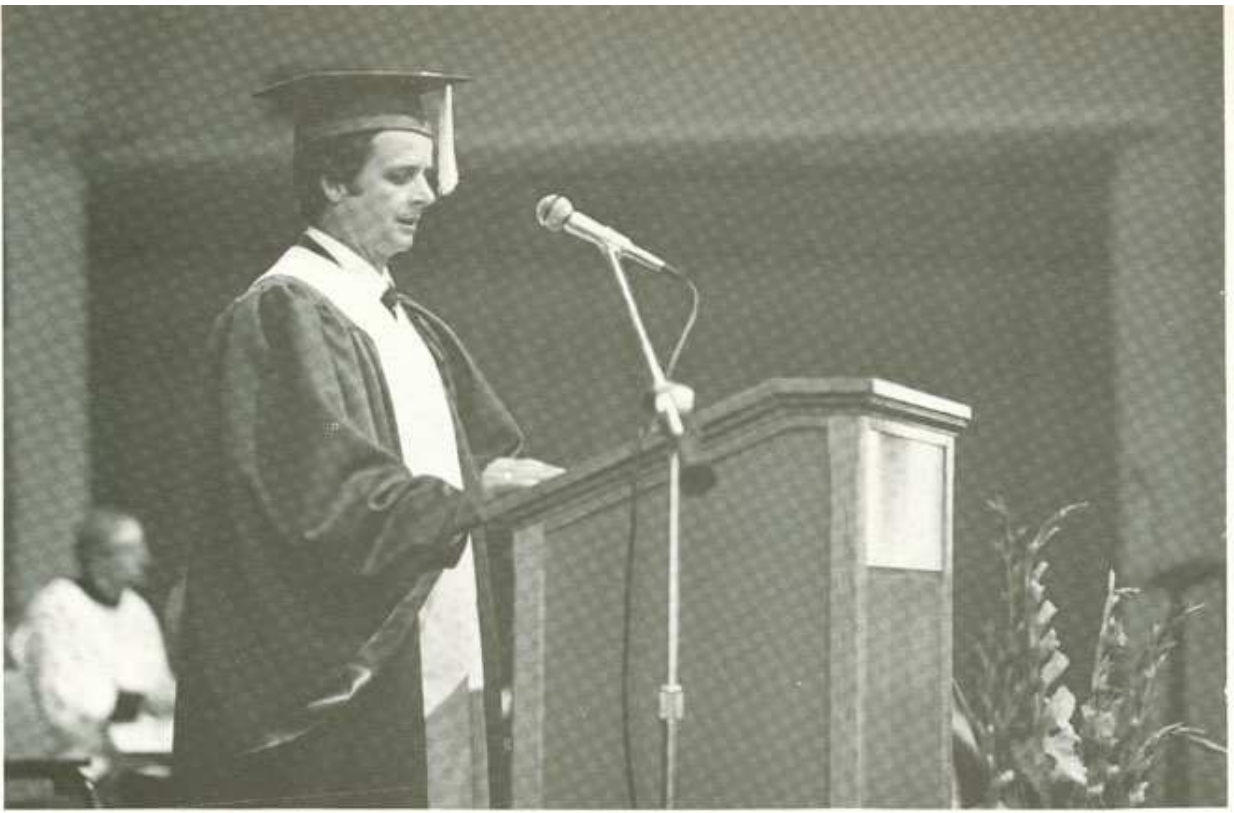
To the Graduating Class of 1980:

Each year at University is crowded with new experiences. For all of us it has been an opportunity for further growth--intellectually, socially, morally.

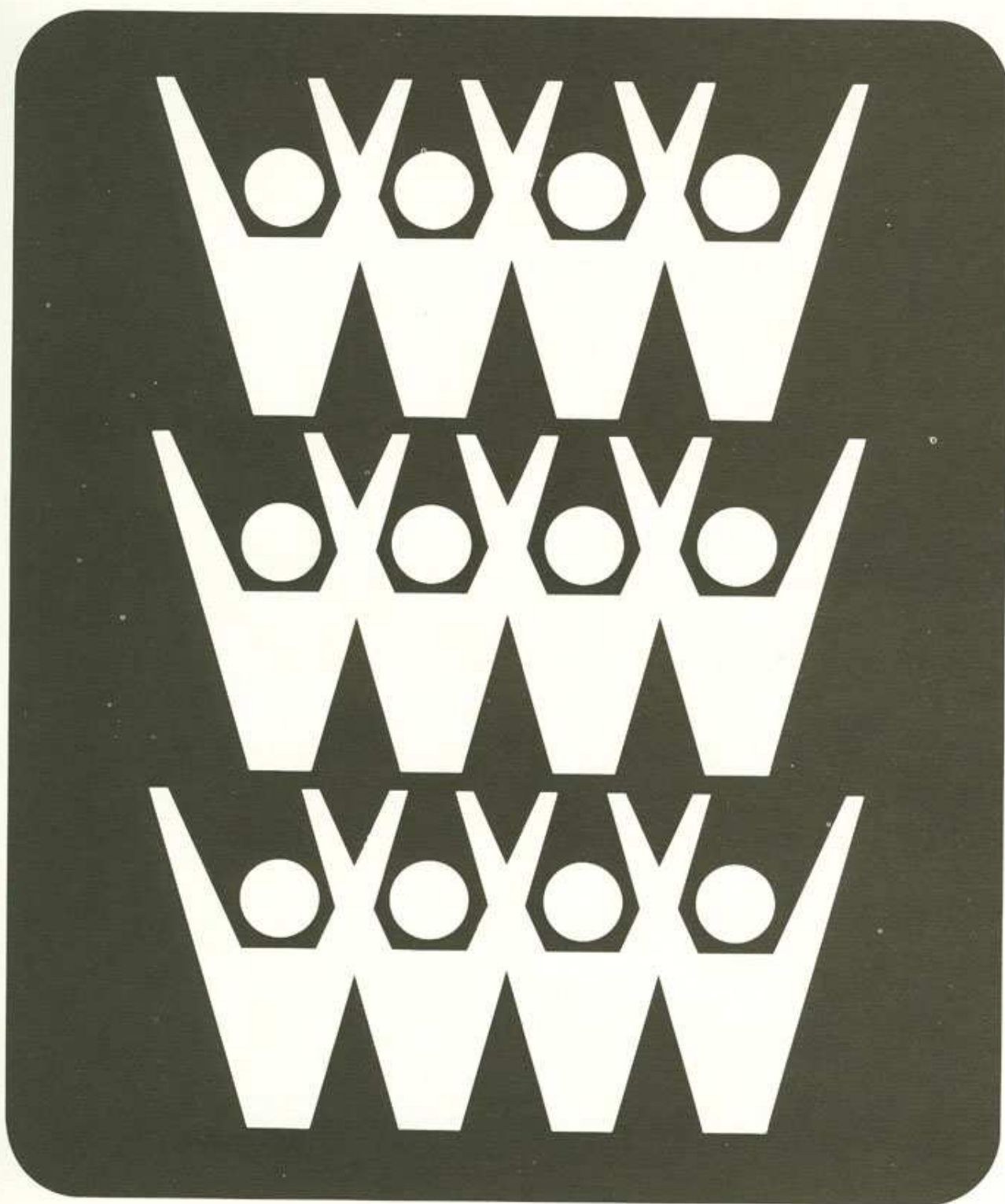

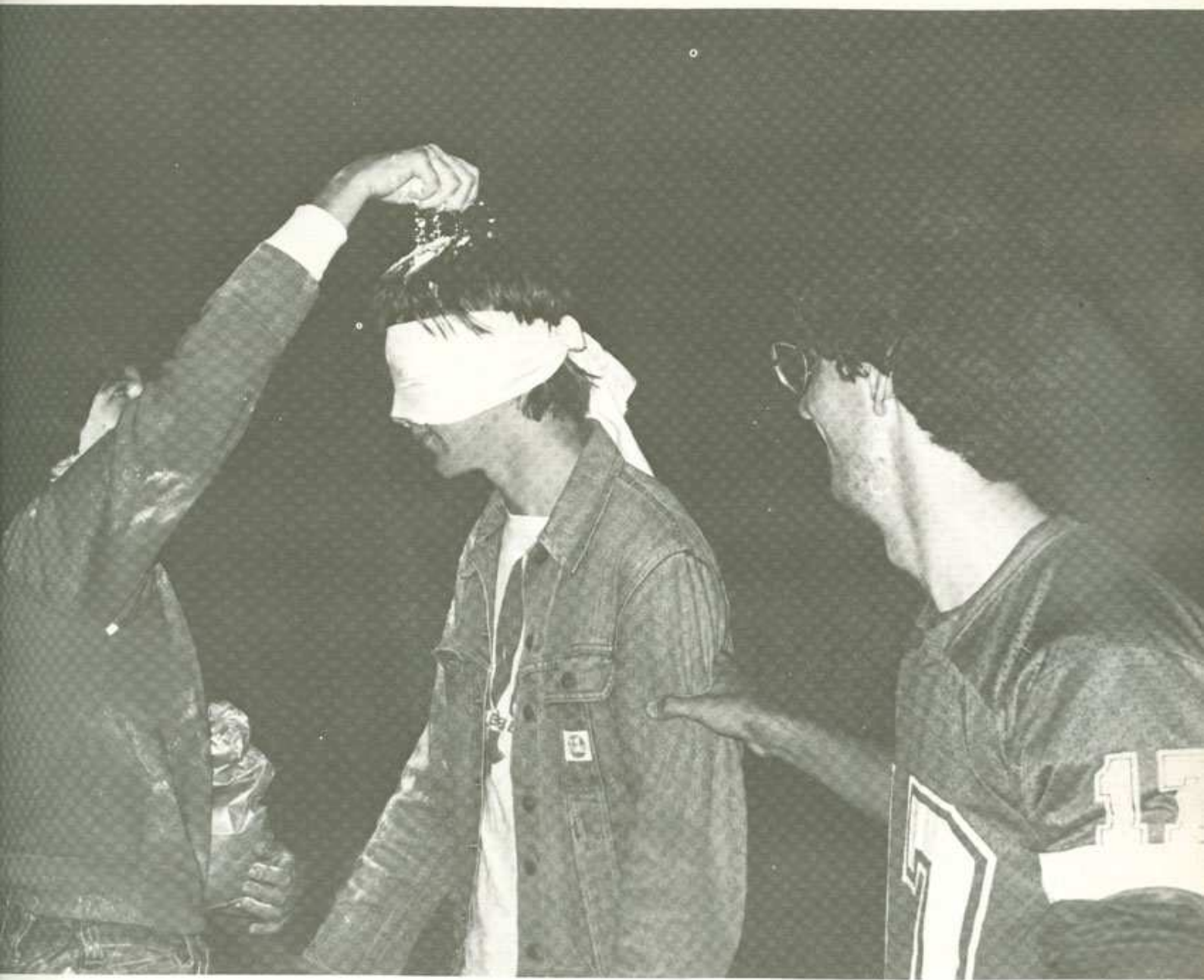

The O'Donnell-Hennessey Student Centre Dedication

Two long-time Santamarians, close to the hearts of many Saint Mary's students of the past forty years, were honoured on October 14.

A program of worship, social gathering and formal recognition centred on the dedication of the Student Centre at Saint Mary's in the names of Father Michael J. O'Donnell and Father John J. Hennessey.

Over the years Father O'Donnell and Father Hennessey have endeared themselves, each in his own way, to the students of Saint Mary's. Though their personalities were different, each maintained close contact with students through his position as Dean of Men, as counsellor, and through an active interest in athletics and a genuine dedication to Saint Mary's and its students.

Reverend Michael J. O'Donnell, S.J. came to Saint Mary's in 1941. He has been described as that good, old-fashioned type of teacher who brooked no nonsense in academic pursuits — the kind that commanded respect at the time and appreciation and admiration with the passing years. Father O'Donnell was a teacher of Latin and English. As Moderator of Athletics he is remembered for having put forth great effort to maintain and build sports programs through times when money was tight. However, despite his enthusiasm for sports, academic excellence was never sacrificed in its favour. Father O'Donnell's commitment to academic strength at Saint Mary's was also reflected in his emphasis on public speaking and debating. Father O'Donnell earned the nickname "Buck" through his enforcement of the rules when it was compulsory for students (all male) to wear ties. If a student was caught without a tie, he was immediately fined a "Buck." Father O'Donnell has retired from active academic service but continues to reside in the Jesuit residence at Saint Mary's. He continues to take an active part in Alumni activities. Because of the important place he holds in the hearts of so many alumni, it is most appropriate that Father "Buck" O'Donnell contributes regularly to the Alumni publication, the *Maroon and White*, compiling the "Snippets" page which keeps track of the movements and accomplishments of Saint Mary's alumni.

Reverend John J. Hennessey, S.J. joined Saint Mary's in 1961. While he had taught in his younger years, Father Hennessey's first love was preaching and pastoral work. It is for his warm personal relationships with students that he is most remembered by alumni. The sixties and early seventies saw a lot of changes in the attitudes of university students and it has been said that it was the mark of the man that he was able to adapt to these changes, albeit sometimes grudgingly, while still retaining his dedication to his basic beliefs and religious commitment. Like Father O'Donnell, Father Hennessey was involved in sports and is still a regular figure at Saint Mary's sporting events. His main work at Saint Mary's has been and still is that of a counsellor. In that capacity, he keeps rather surprising hours for a man of his age; the sign on his door indicating his "office" hours includes his availability for counselling until 2:00 a.m. Father Hennessey has, of course, been given a number of nicknames over the years but the most enduring seems to be "Hen" and a concourse through the residences, adorned by some fine student artwork including a very good likeness of the man himself, is known as "Hen" Alley.

When students of the past return to Saint Mary's for a visit, it is Father O'Donnell and Father Hennessey who are most frequently searched out. And it is important to note that the idea behind the dedication of the Student Centre came straight from the alumni and present students, out of an obvious and deep love for these two men. As the plaque on the M.J. O'Donnell-J.J. Hennessey Student Centre will read, "... both have been friends to all who needed kindness, compassion, friendship and assistance. This building's name recognizes gratefully their wise counsel and wholehearted devotion to Saint Mary's University."

At the dedication ceremony official tributes were offered by Kevin Cleary and Bob Hayes.

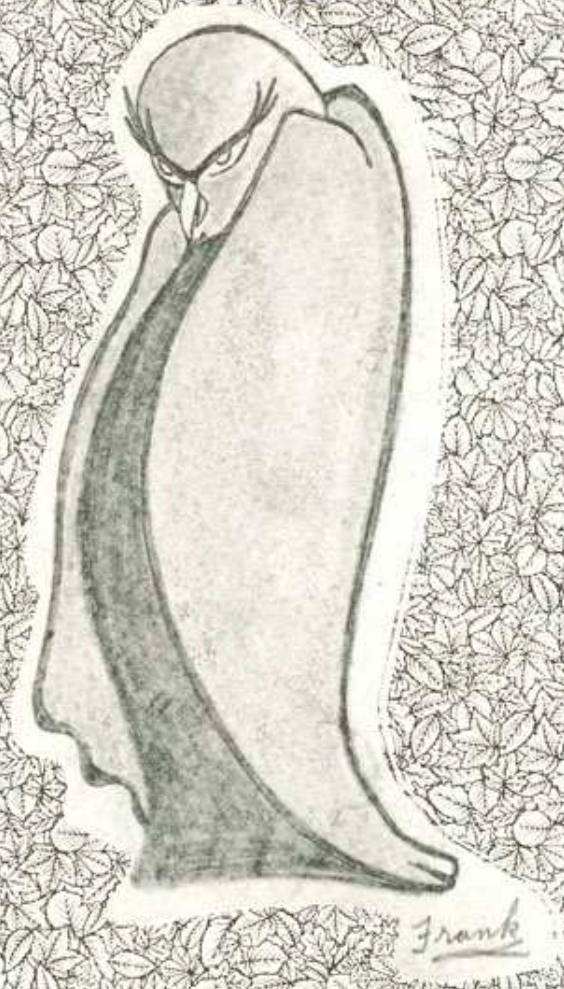
I would like to take this opportunity to personally congratulate all the graduates and wish them success in the years to come.

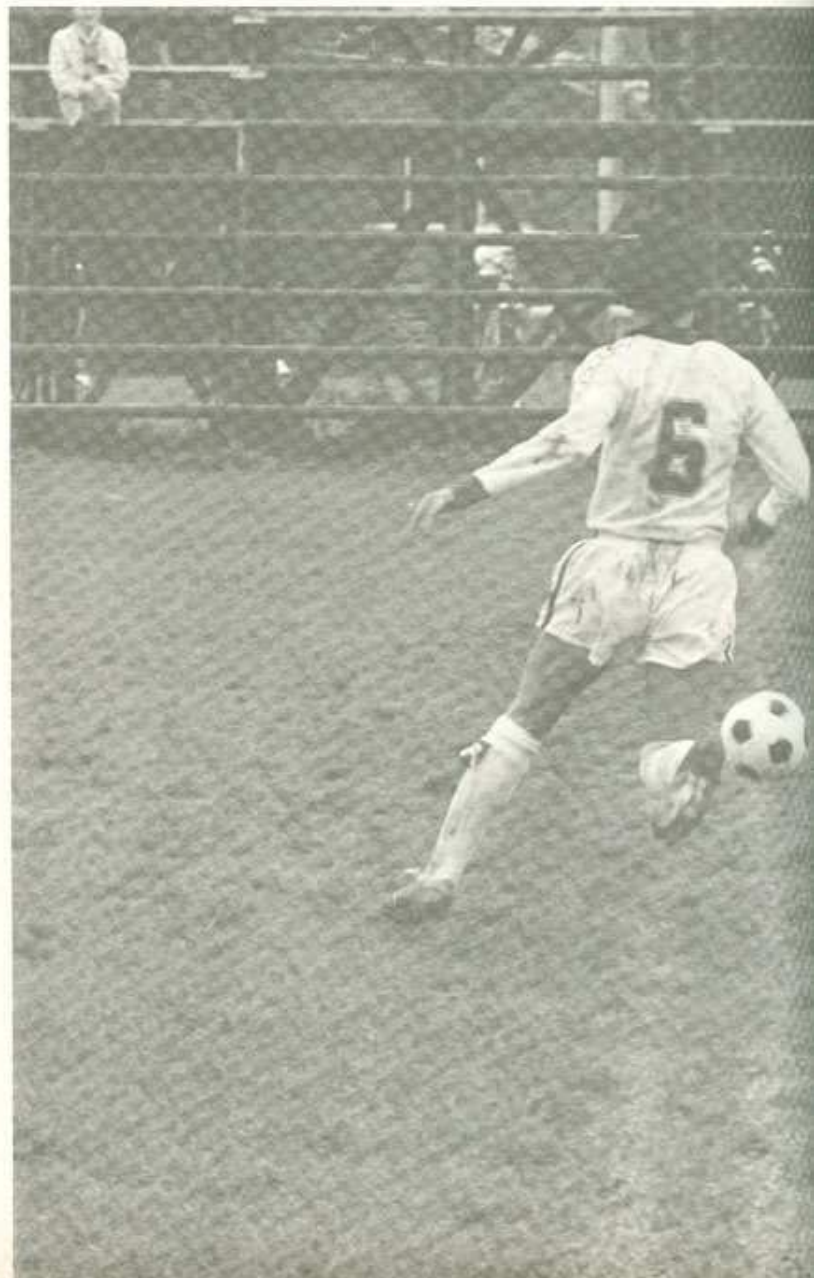

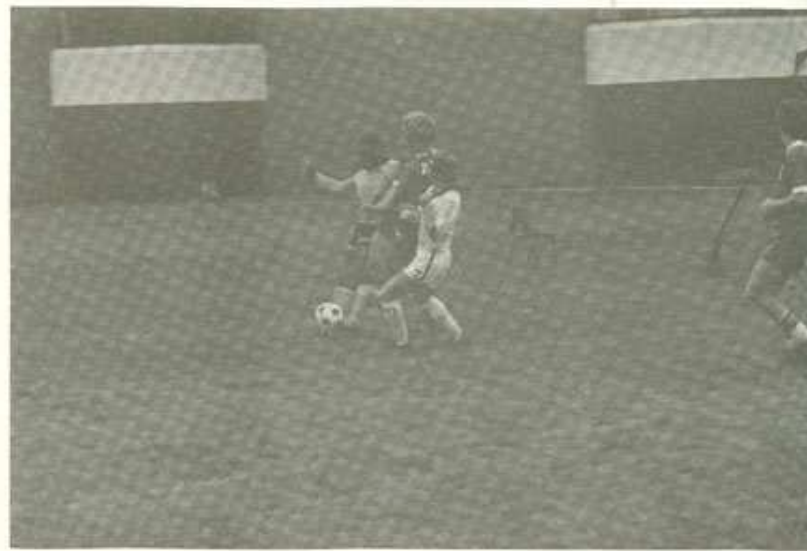
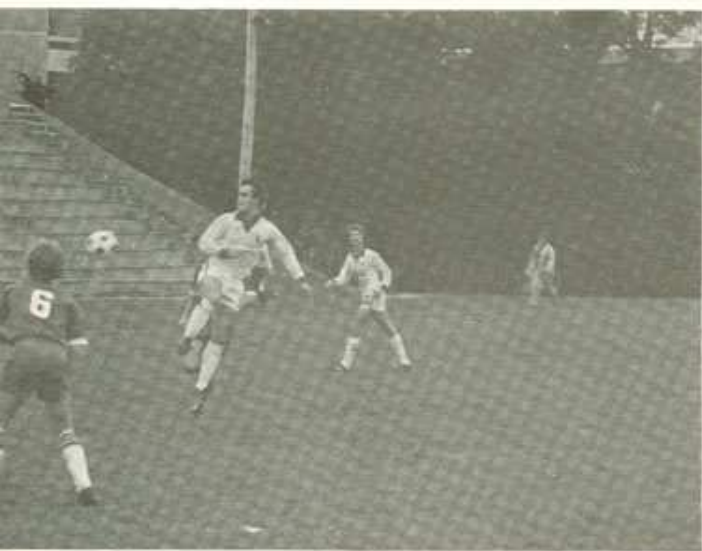

The Soccer Huskies, under the tutelage of Head Coach Roy Clements, continued their dominance of the A.U.A.A. for the second consecutive year. After failing to capture the league crown in 78-79, Clements was determined to bring home the title in 79-80.

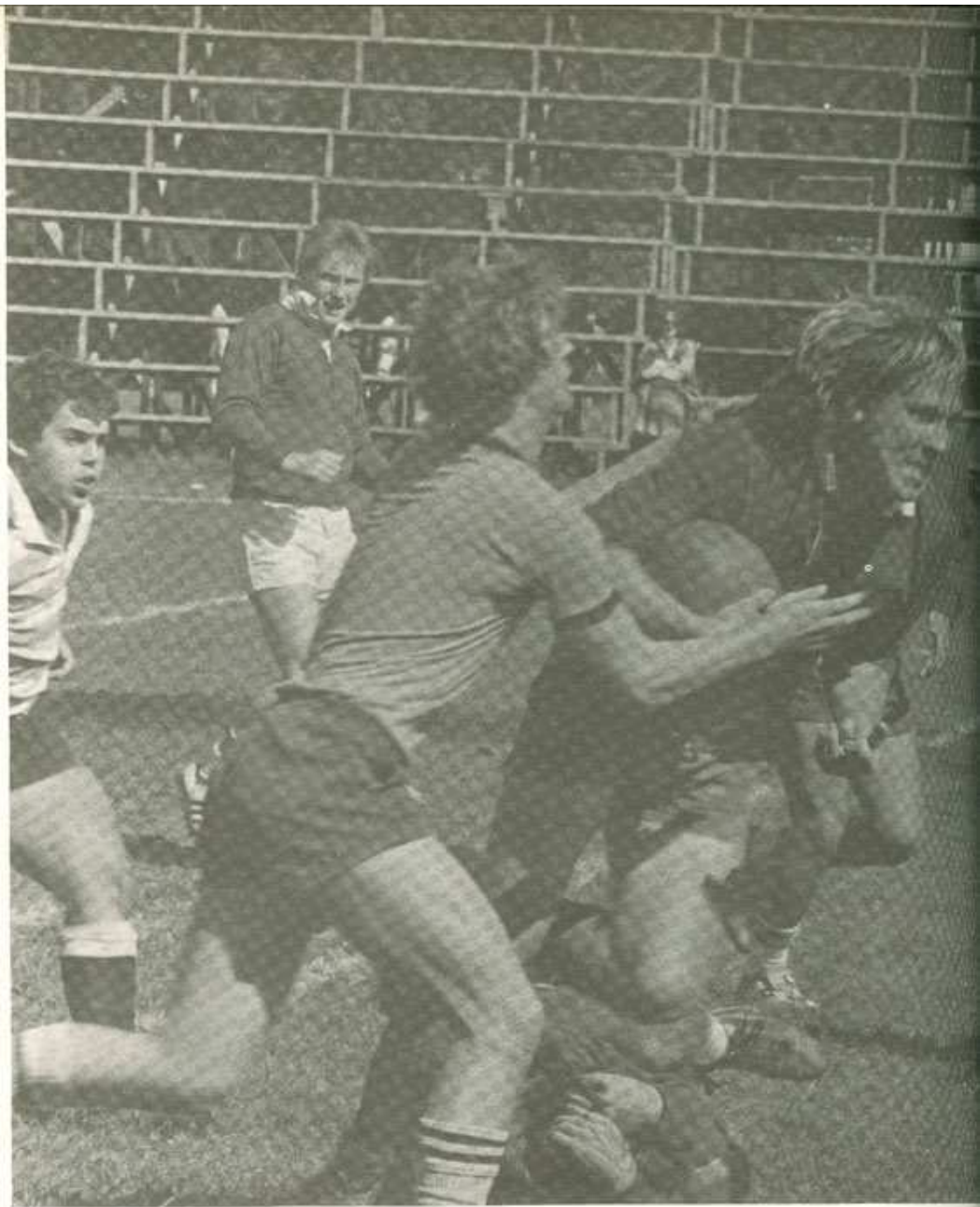
An 8-1-1 regular season record gave the Santamarians first place in the conference. The Huskies ousted the Memorial Beothuks in opening round action, then won a tight battle over the U.N.B. Red Shirts after two overtime periods and penalty kicks. It was the third Atlantic Championship for Coach Clements; the third ending a 13 year drought since the second title.

It was on to the Eastern Canadian Championships at Concordia, and another tie brought on penalty kicks. The Huskies were again favoured and earned a berth in the National final against the University of Alberta. The Albertans proved tougher, and the Huskies returned home with a second place finish in Canada.

A.U.A.A. All-Stars included Huskies Mark Clarke, Manuk Nazaryan, Alan Routledge, Ross Webb, and Jim Sidey. Nazaryan was selected to the All-Canadian First Team and Jim Sidey to the second squad.

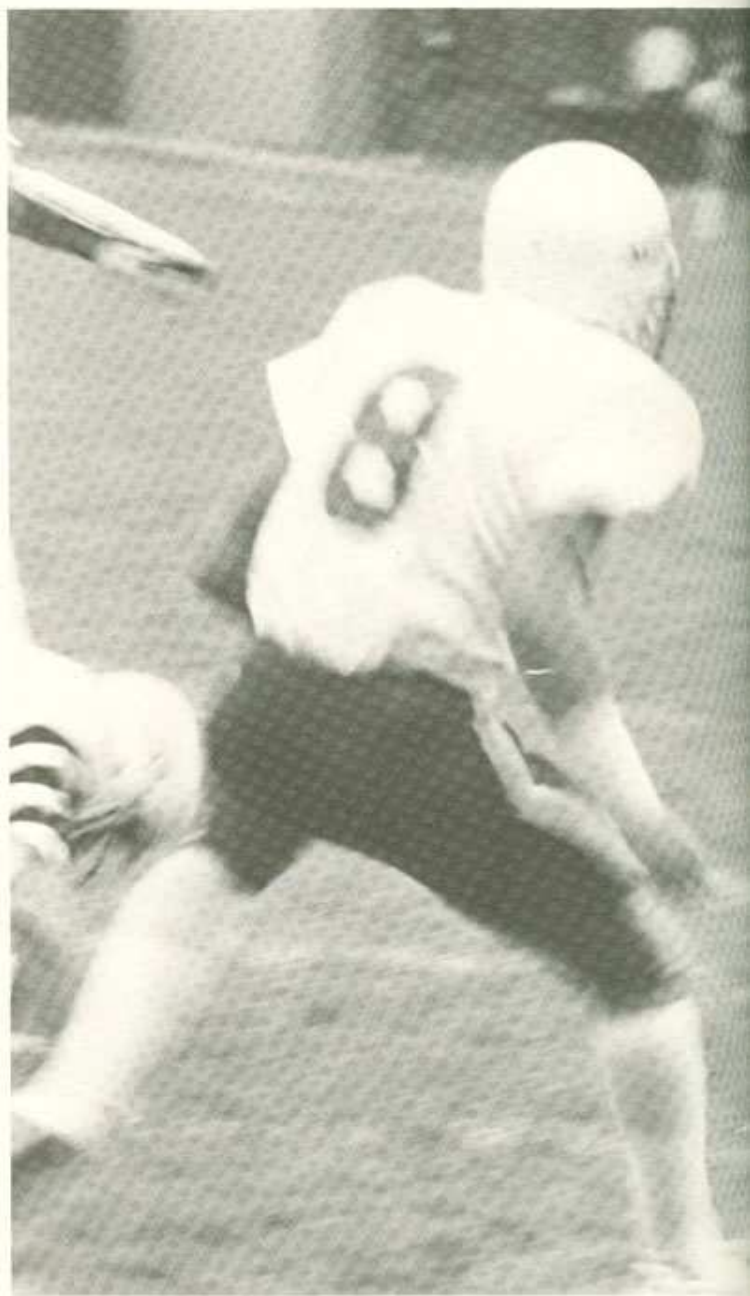

Back at the helm of the Huskies after a three year absence, Head Coach Al Keith piloted his 1979 team to a respectable 4-3 league record and a third place conference finish.

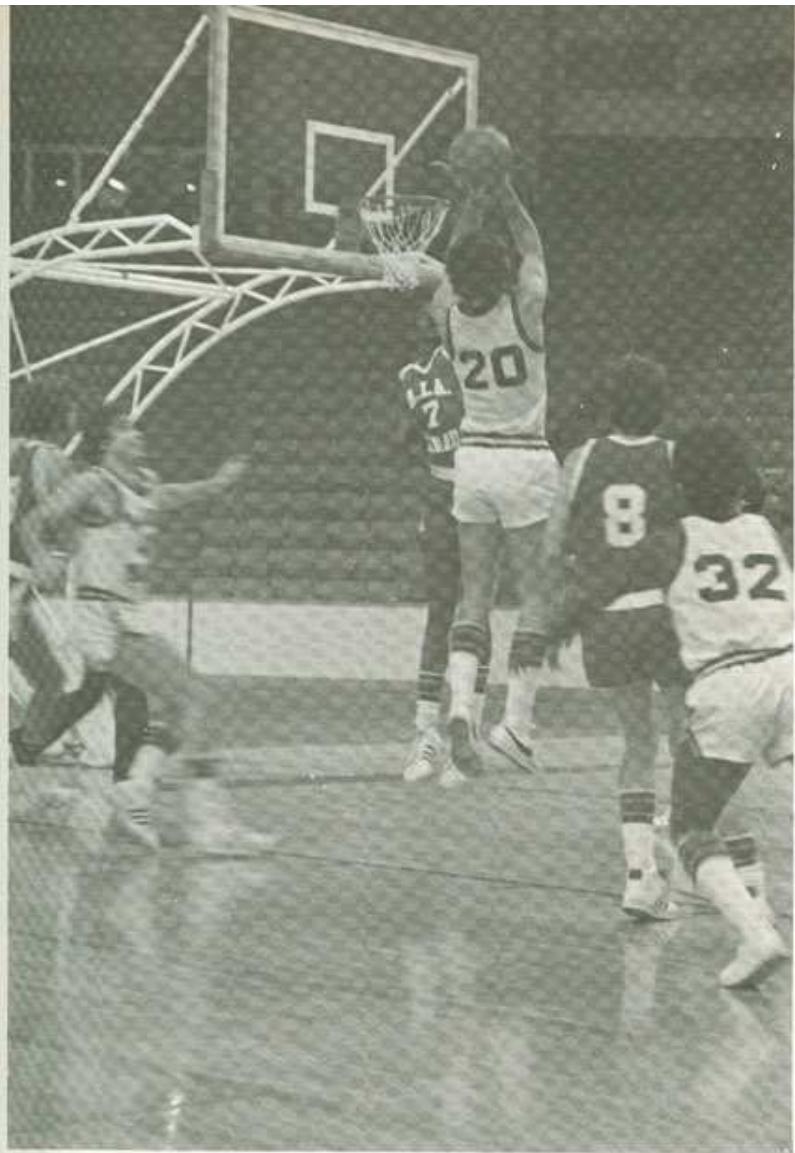
Two of their three losses were against the Canadian Champion Acadia Axemen, and the other came when the Huskies travelled to Antigonish to meet the St. Francis Xavier X-Men. Wins were against the U.P.E.I. Panthers, the U.N.B. Red Bombers, Mt. Allison Mounties, and the St. F.X. X-Men. The late season victory over the X-Men gave credibility to pre-season predictions for steady improvement by the young club as the schedule progressed.

Defensively, the 1979 Huskies earned plaudits from every team in the league. Linebackers Mark Heidebrecht and Mike DeGenova were selected to the Conference All-Stars, and DeGenova was also chosen to the All-Canadian team. Punter Neil Ellison also earned post-season laurels for the second year in a row as a member of the All-Conference squad. Running back Brian Murray did an outstanding job when he was called upon to fill in for injured starter James Boyd, and tackles Larry Stewart and Bob Gray played with the best in the league.

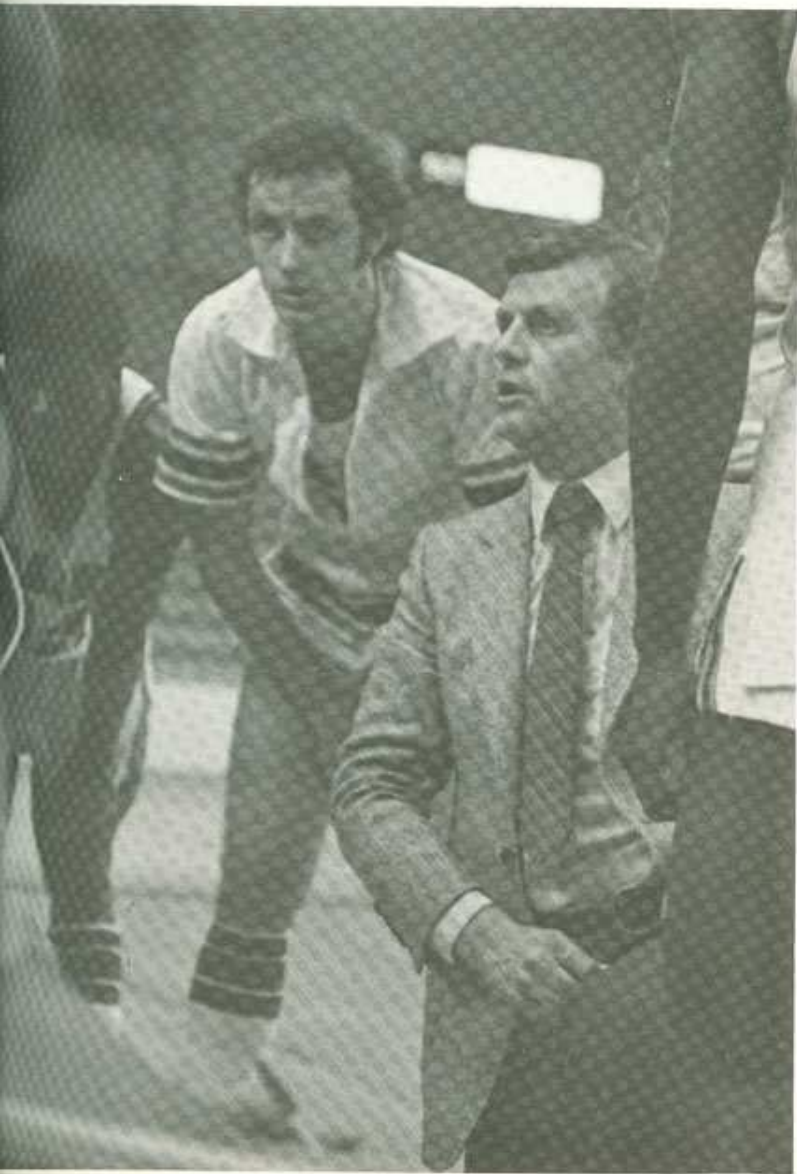
The Football Huskies provided many exciting moments, falling inches short of securing a playoff berth. A successful season, but one Coach Keith hopes to improve upon next year.

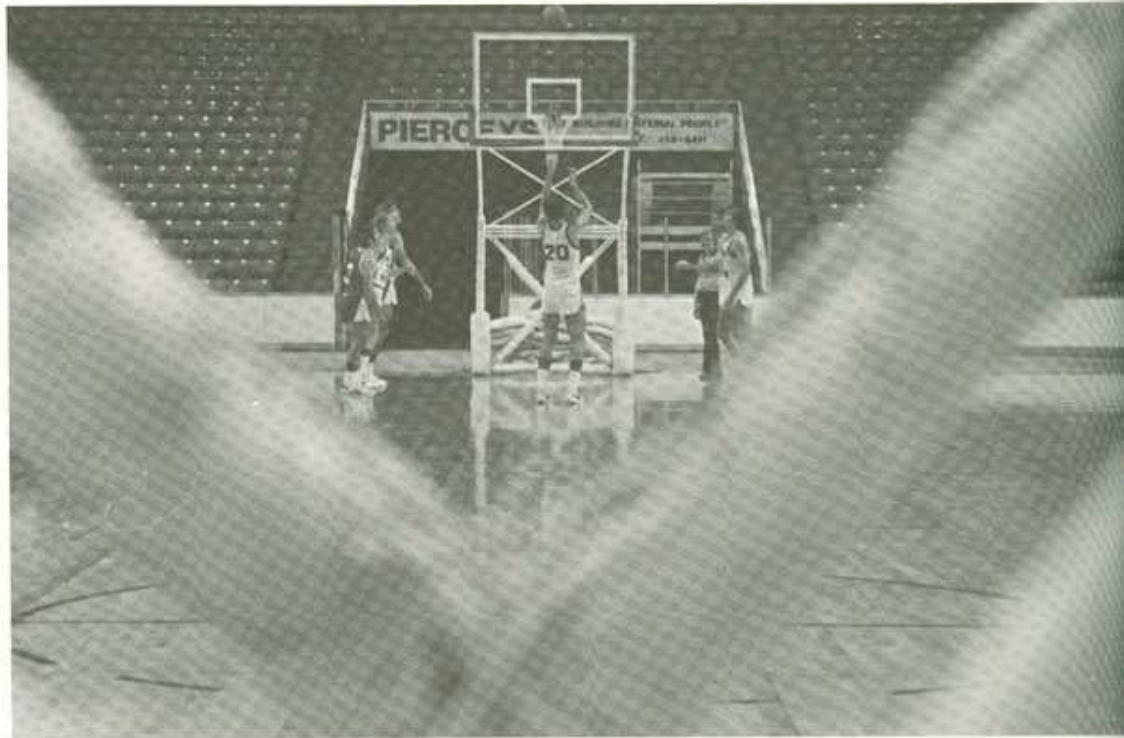
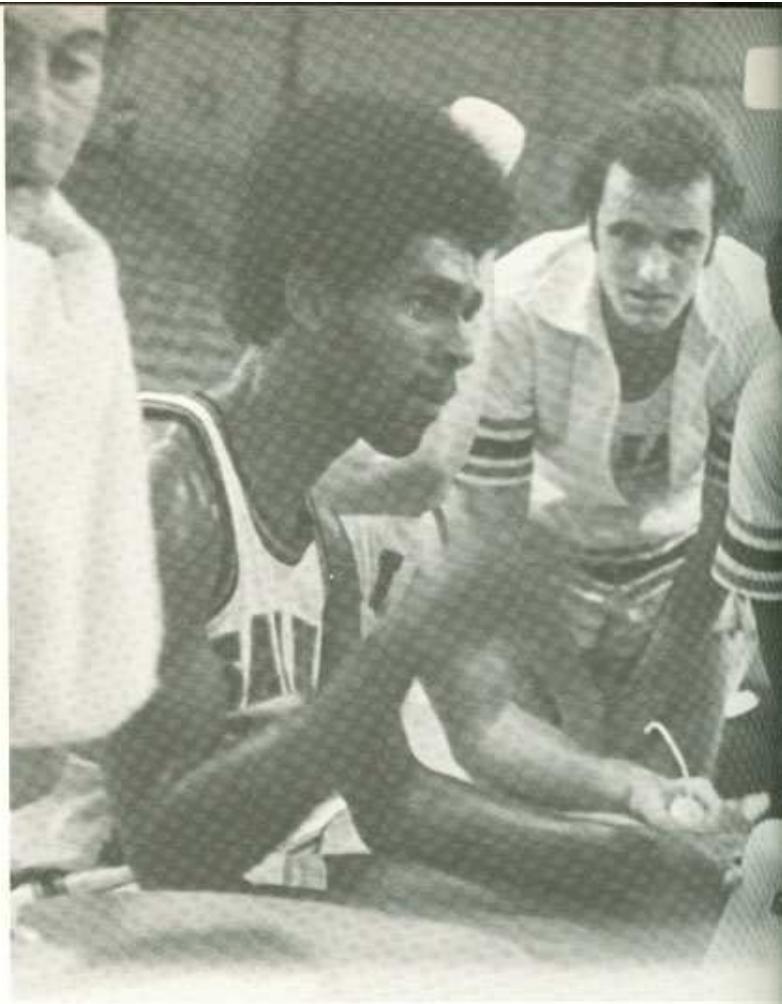

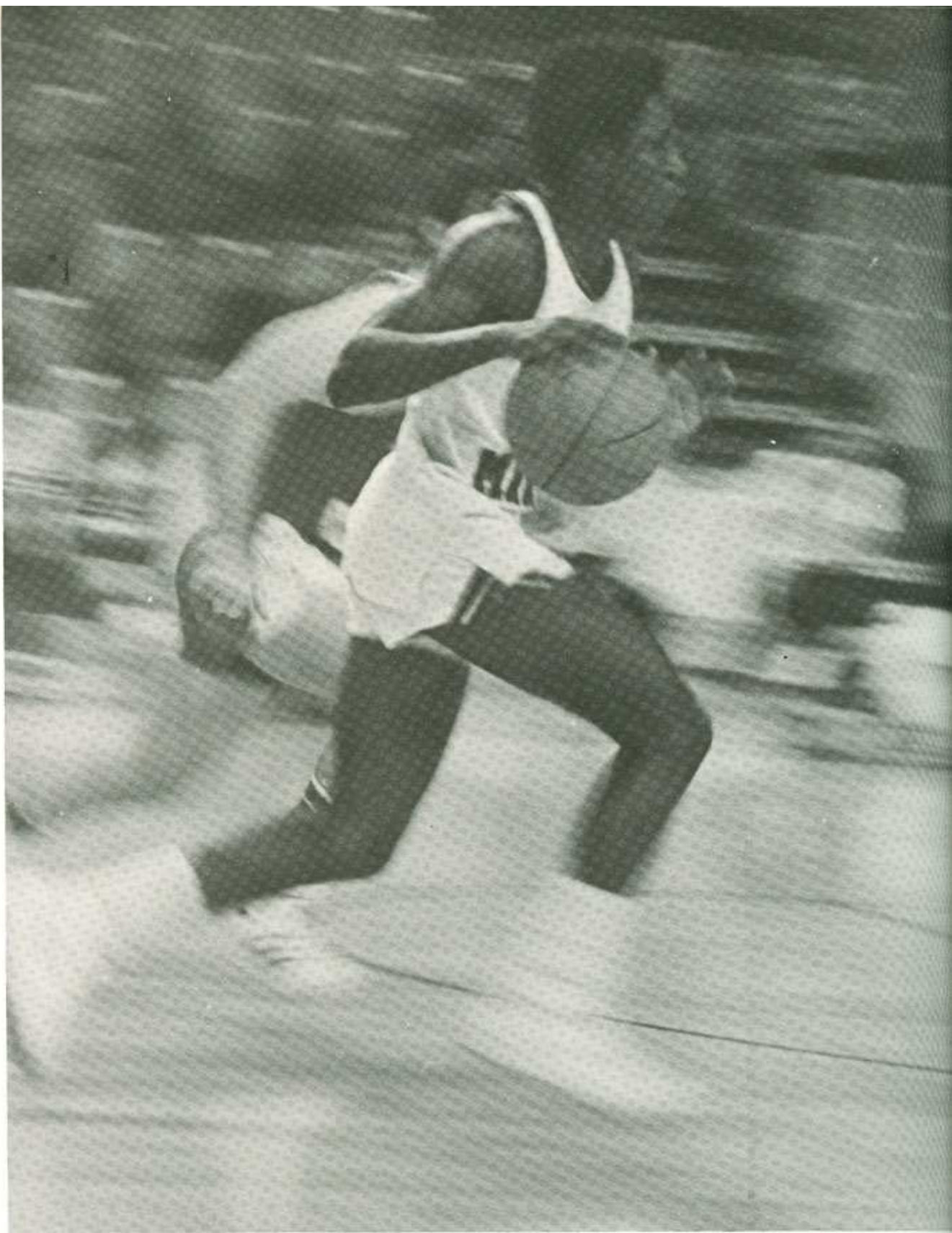


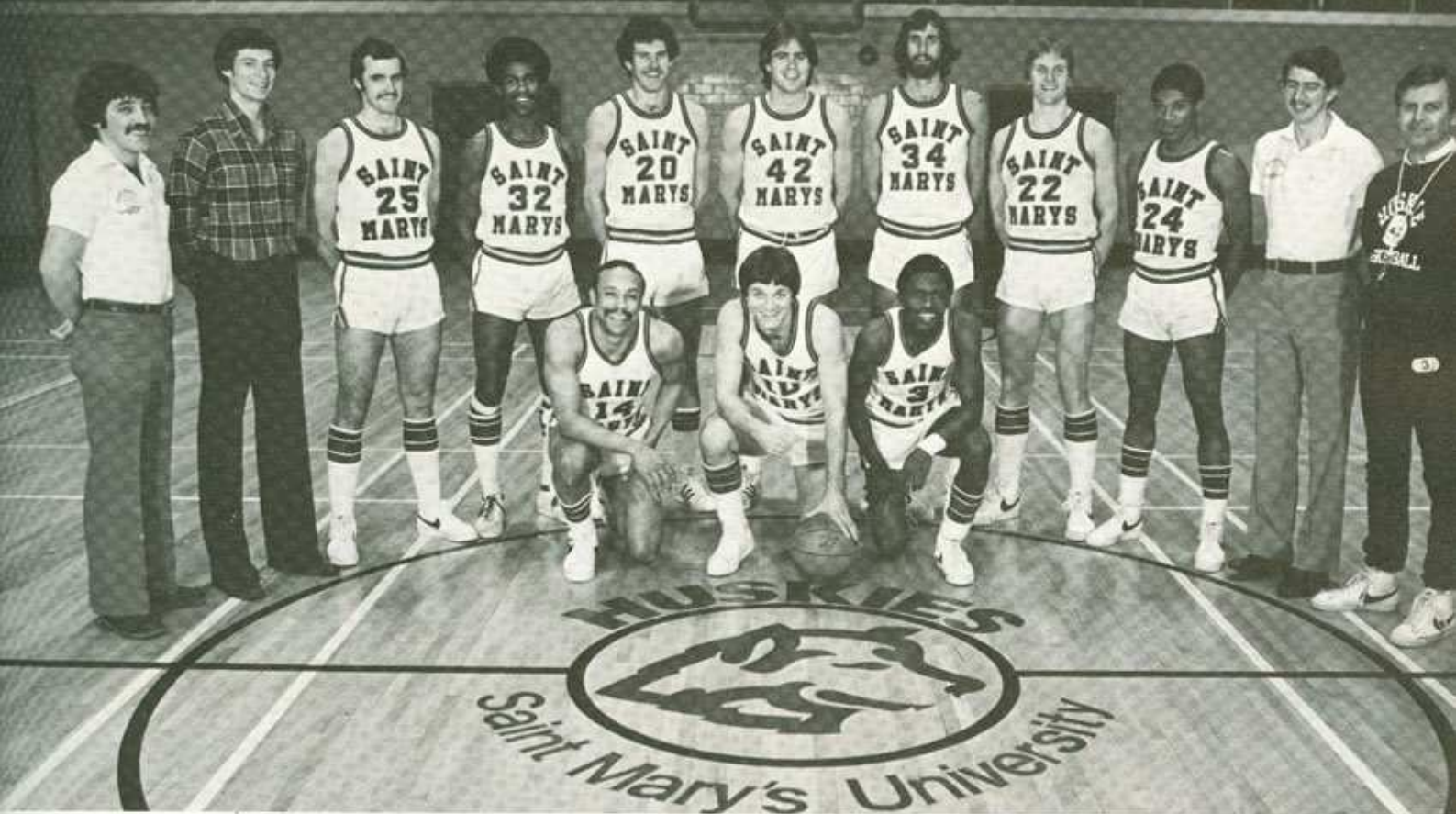












Mens Basketball Team 1979-80

New Head Coach Gary Heald faced an awesome task when he accepted lead reins to the club which held the Canadian Championship for the past two consecutive years. Veterans Ron Blommers, Rick Plato, Ross Quackenbush, and Ivan Ross combined with newcomers John Dronsella, Lee Davis, Mike Mansfield, Maurice King, and James Boyd to attack their schedule head on.

When the season concluded, the Huskies had carried on their winning tradition under a new coach. A 15-3 league record and first

place finish gave them a definite advantage in the playoffs. After a victory over Acadia in preliminary competition, the Huskies went on to defeat St. Francis Xavier in the championship game for the A.U.A.A. title. Quackenbush, Blommers, and Davis earned berths on the All-Conference team, and Davis was chosen A.U.A.A. Rookie of the Year. Plato, Quackenbush, and Blommers were selected to the A.U.A.A. Tournament All-Star Team.

It was on to Calgary for the National Finals where Quackenbush and Davis earned honourable mention to the All-Canadian squad. Davis also made the C.I.A.U. All-Freshman team. Davis was an all-star in every tournament he played throughout the year — an achievement most rookies could never attain. The Huskies defeated Concordia at the Nationals, then lost to University of Victoria. In the consolation round, they beat Winnipeg to finish in third place.

Overall, the Santamarians led the nation both in scoring with a 96.5 point per game average and in shooting from the floor with 56.8 percent. Blommers led the C.I.A.U. in shooting with 68.0 percent. All five starters averaged in the double figure for the year's scoring.

His first year behind the Huskies bench yielded a multitude of laurels for Gary Heald and he certainly accomplished all that he set out to do.

Helen Castonguay found a challenge awaiting her when she accepted head coaching duties to the Basketball Belles at the beginning of the 1979-80 season. A lineup comprised of only four returning players from the previous team provided a test for Helen's coaching skills.

The Belles started off the season with two losses to Dal and St. F.X., then defeated Acadia before losing to Dal in their final pre-Christmas game. The second part of the schedule produced four wins and eight losses, bringing their overall record to 5-11 for a fourth place conference finish.

Team Captain Dianne Chiasson was the league's leading rebounder and second highest scorer. Chiasson earned a spot on the A.U.A.A. All-Conference Team and the Starting Lineup All-Canadian squad. The season highlight came during the Christmas tournament at McGill when the Belles lost by only two points to Boston College, a highly ranked American team.

Head Coach Bob Boucher was behind the Huskies bench for his thirteenth year, and hoped to make it a lucky 13th. He already boasted the best won-lost record in Canadian college hockey, and wanted to improve upon that achievement while molding a national contender.

A 5-7-1 pre-Christmas conference record fell short of their goal, but the Huskies came out ready for the backstretch, compiling a 12-3-1 record for an overall 17-10-2 record. Goalkeeper Mark Locken finished the year with the best goals against average of 2.61 and earned All-Conference and All-Canadian honours for his efforts. Darren Pickrem joined Locken on the A.U.A.A. First Team All-Stars, and Kevin Reinhart made the Second A.U.A.A. squad.

The Huskies defeated Mt. Allison in preliminary playoff competition, then lost a disappointing best of three series to the Universite de Moncton, who went on to win the Atlantic championship.

After 13 years at the helm of the Maroon & White, Bob Boucher accepted a one year term as Assistant Coach with the Philadelphia Flyers, leaving the 1980-81 Huskies to former star player Brian O'Byrne.

Mace New Addition to Saint Mary's Convocation

Besides having a new President and a new graduating class, this year's Convocation will have another new addition. The Saint Mary's University mace will be put to its first ceremonial use at the 1980 Convocation. The mace itself is brand new, with the University receiving it officially from its makers at H.M.C. Dockyard in a ceremony on Thursday, May 8.

The mace was originally an offensive weapon made of iron or steel — a strong, heavy, and often specialized club, capable of breaking through armour. About the sixteenth century the mace began undergoing a change in its usage — from a weapon to a ceremonial symbol. Basically, it became a symbol of royal authority, and then a symbol of other forms of authority. In the case of a university the mace symbolizes primarily the authority to grant degrees and for this reason it is customarily carried at the lead of the convocation procession and rests in a prominent place during the conferring of degrees.

In the Saint Mary's University Convocation procession the mace will be carried by the Marshal of Convocation, Chairman of Senate, Dr. Arthur Monahan.

Saint Mary's mace is made of oak, with a cast brass crown, and brass plates carrying traditional ceremonial engravings. The prominent head of the mace features a cross — an extension of the oak body — which extends above the brass crown which encircles it.

The mace was designed by George Somers, Director of the Physical Plant, and drawn by Clement Rodrique. It was made in the Ship Repair Atlantic workshops by Don Wright, Bob Mills, and Bob Stoneman, under the supervision of Gerry Arnold, Vice-Admiral John Allan, Commander Maritime Command.

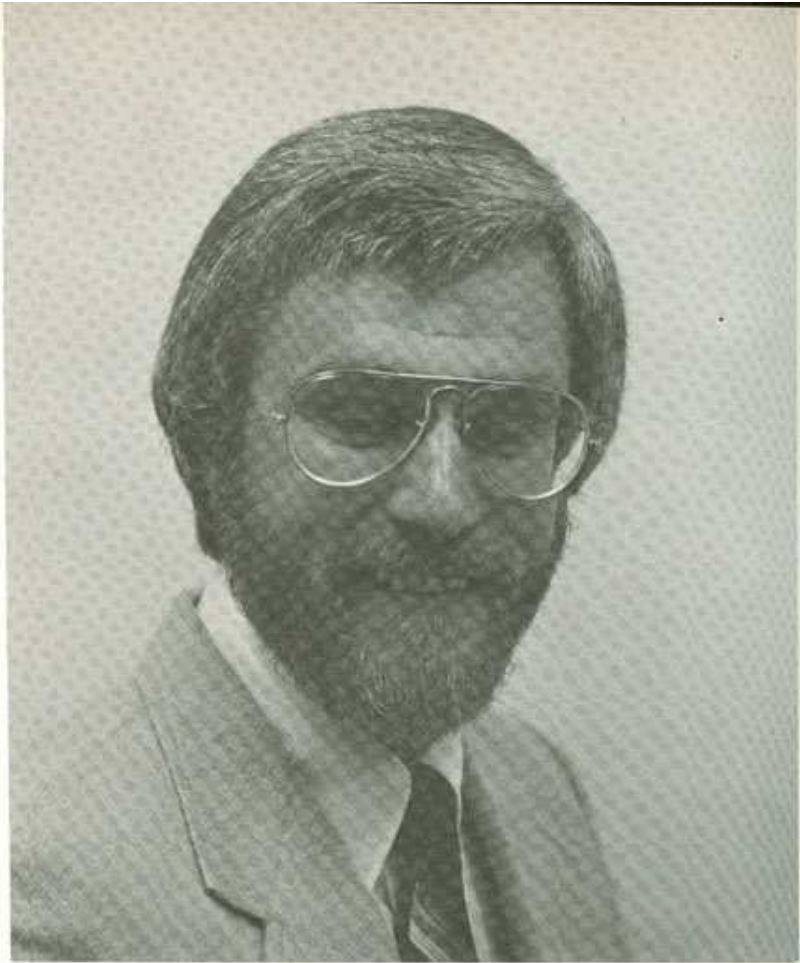

Coal Power.

Nova Scotia coal has become an increasingly significant factor in our efforts to reduce our dependence on imported oil.

In October of 1979 the first coal-fired generating unit at Lingan became operational. The second unit will begin production this fall. Together, these units will require 800,000 tons of Cape Breton coal annually.

This use of 'coal power' (which will replace more than 3 million barrels of oil each year) is but one indication of the Corporation's realistic approach to the problem of reducing our reliance on offshore oil.

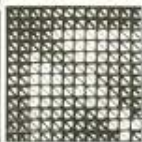

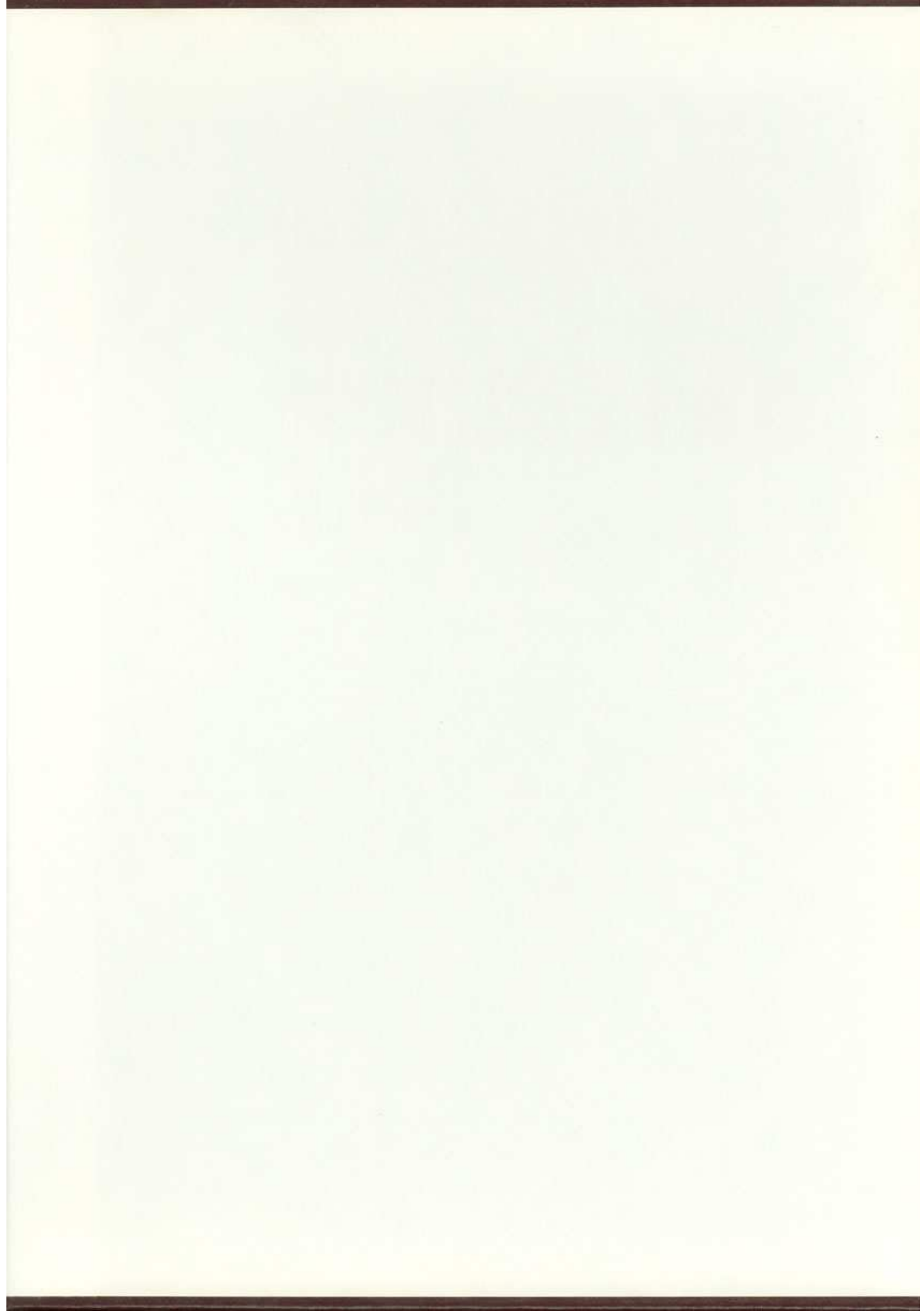
