Four to be honored at Convocation

At Convocation on May 11, Saint Mary's will confer honorary degrees on five distinguished Canadians.

Matthew William Barrett

Born in Kells, County Meath, Ireland, Matthew Barrett was 18 when he joined the bank of Montreal as a clerk in London in 1962. He transferred to Canada in 1967 and rose rapidly through 16 positions, each more senior than the last, entering the executive ranks in 1978 as Vice-President Management Services. After a series of moves through different departments of the bank, he took charge of its retail branch operations in 1985, and in 1987 was elected President and Chief Operating Officer. He became Chief Executive Officer in 1989 and was elected Chairman of the Board of Directors in 1990, becoming, at 45, one of the youngest senior banking executives in the world. Matthew Barrett sits on a number of boards and advisor committees, including those of the Business Council on National Issues and York University.

Roberta Lynn Bondar

Roberta Bondar, who represented Canada as a payload specialist on NASA's mission STS-42 in January 1992, holds a B.Sc. (Guelph, 1968), an M.Sc. (Western Ontario, 1971), a Ph.D. (Toronto, 1974) and a Doctor of Medicine degree (McMaster, 1977). She is a neurologist and a clinical and basic science researcher in the nervous system.

Dr. Bondar was one of the six Canadian astronauts selected in 1983 and began training in 1984. She was designated a prime payload specialist for the first International Microgravity Laboratory Mission in 1990. Dr. Bondar has served as a member of the Ontario Premier's Council on Science and Technology and on many other scientific bodies. She has received many honors and was made an honorary life member of Girl Guides in Canada in 1986. Her professional affiliations include the American Academy of Neurology, the Canadian Neurological Society, the Canadian Aeronautics and Space Institute, and the American Society for Gravitational and Space Biology.

Nelly Beveridge Gray

An artist and a traveller, Nelly Gray was born in England, but her family moved to Nova Scotia in 1912 and then to Detroit in 1924. She graduated as a registered nurse in Detroit in 1929, celebrating with a bus journey to California that led to a voyage through the Panama Canal. This was the first of the multitude of adventurous journeys with which her life has been filled. From 1935 to 1949, she looked after Mr. and Mrs. Booth, retired newspaper publishers who founded the Cranbrook Educational Institution, north of Detroit. With them she travelled widely and also enrolled in the Institution to earn both bachelor's and master's degrees in fine arts. She paints in watercolors and acrylic and has always experimented with materials, receiving an award for innovation from the American Watercolor Society in the 1960s.

Her enthusiasm for art and travel brought Mrs. Gray to another major achievement. On the chance suggestion of an acquaintance, she invested a method of making rubbings from stone carvings. From then on, she applied her artistic sensitivity to recording the relief sculptures of ancient civilizations by making rubbings in museums around the world. Her work was shown in the University's art gallery in 1972, 1982, 1989 and 1990.

Anna Porter

Born in Hungary, Anna Porter was educated in New Zealand and has a B.A. and an M.A. from Canterbury University. She began her publishing career in London, England, and came to Canada in 1968, joining McClelland & Stewart in 1969 and rising to Vice-President and Editor-in-Chief. In 1978, she became President of McClelland-Bantam Inc. In 1981, she started Key Porter Books Limited of which she is President. Key Porter is a 50 per cent shareholder in Seal Books, which publishes such authors as Margaret Atwood, Farley Mowat and W. O. Mitchell.

Anna Porter is dedicated to Canadian publishing and has worked to raise its profile internationally. She is recognized as a dedicated supporter of Canadian authors and fought the imposition of the GST on books and has lectured and given speeches throughout Canada about culture and publishing. Anna Porter is on the board of Laurential Financial, Peoples Jewellers Ltd., Hollinger Inc., UNICEF Canada and the World Wildlife Fund Canada. She was made an Officer of the Order of Canada in 1992.

Retirements

The following faculty members are retiring from Saint Mary's University, after devoting a total of 127 years to serving the University.

Dr. Vedat N. Baydar (Marketing)

Dr. Baydar was born in Bursa, Turkey, and received a bachelor's degree, an M.A. and a Ph.D. from the Academy of Economic and Commercial Sciences in Istanbul, Turkey. He came to Saint Mary's as an assistant professor in the Accounting and Business Administrative Department in 1968, was promoted to associate professor in 1972 and received tenure in 1973. He served three terms as chairperson of the Marketing Department, in 1978-79, 1982-85 and 1989-1990. He is retiring after 24 years at Saint Mary's.

Dr. Dattatraya Govind Kabe (Mathematics and Computing Science)

Dr. Kabe received a B.Sc. and an M.Sc. from the University of Bombay, an M.Sc. from Karnatak University, India, and a Ph.D. from Wayne State University, Detroit, Michigan. He came to Canada in 1966 and joined Saint Mary's as an associate professor in the Mathematics Department in 1968. He received tenure in 1973 and was promoted to full professor in 1975. He is retiring after 24 years at Saint Mary's University.

Dr. Francis Phillips (Education)

Dr. Phillips was born in Saint John, New Brunswick, and graduated from Saint Michael's College High School in Toronto. He obtained a B.A. from the University of New Brunswick, then went to the University of London as a Beaverbrook Scholar. There he obtained his M.A. and Ph.D. He joined Saint Mary's Faculty of Education in 1965 and has specialized in the history of education. He served two terms as Acting Dean of Education, in 1981-82 and 1986-87.

Dr. Enriqueta Unturbe-Rojo (Biology)

Dr. Rojo was born in Zaragoza, Spain, and received a B.Sc. and an M.Sc. from Madrid University, qualifying as a registered nurse at the medical school of Madrid University. She came to Saint Mary's in 1962 as a lecturer in biology and Spanish and was promoted to assistant professor in 1965. She received tenure in 1968, was promoted to associate professor in 1972 and served as chairperson of the Biology Department from 1986 to 1989. Dr. Rojo is retiring after 30 years of service to Saint Mary's.

Dr. Emero Stiegman (Religious Studies)

Dr. Stiegman received a B.A. from Don Bosco College in New Jersey, and an M.A. and a Ph.D. from Fordham College in the United States. He came to Saint Mary's as an assistant professor in 1970, was promoted to associate professor in 1973, to professor in 1980 and served as chairperson of the Religious Studies Department from 1973 to 1975. He was granted tenure in 1975 and is retiring after 22 years of service to Saint Mary's.

The following senior administrator has recently retired from the University:

Robert Gerald Hayes (Athletic Director)

Joining the Royal Canadian Navy at the age of 17 in the electrical branch, Bob Hayes combined his navy service with participation football, basketball, swimming and track and field. In 1958, he left the RCN and, despite offers from Ottawa Rough Riders and the Calgary Stampeders, came to Saint Mary's as coach and Athletic Director. He led the Huskies to glory in the 1960s and 70s, when they won more than 30 regional and four national championships, including the 1972 Vanier Cup. He earned a B.A. with a major in Political Science while working full-time at the University. In 1985, Bob became Special Assistant to the President. He retired in December 1991 after 33 years of service to the University.

The Hooding Ceremony

As you will observe, all the graduates and members of the academic procession are attired in the basic elements of formal academic dress, which at Saint Mary's follows the general guidelines established Oxford and Cambridge Universities in England. Formal attire consists of academic robe, hood and mortar board, although at Saint Mary's the latter is limited to Masters' graduates only. The academic dress worn by each participant depends upon the academic level attained. There is a special attire for the Bachelor level candidates, for the Masters, and the Doctorate. While tradition has dictated the style or cut of the academic attire, each university, for the most part, will amend certain details of the attire to suit its own particular tastes and traditions.

The academic hood which each graduate is wearing symbolizes the degree into which the student will be or has been admitted. The hood itself traces its tradition back to the Middle Ages, when its prototype, with a cowl-like appendage and tail, was used to cover the shoulders in the cold and draughty medieval buildings or in inclement weather. Gradually this garment was modified and the hood assumed an academic rather than functional significance. The hood has two basic elements: the trim on the outer edge and an inner satin lining. Each hood has its outer edge trimmed with a colour to indicate a particular faculty and degree; white symbolizes Arts; gold symbolizes Science; grey Commerce; and white with pale blue symbolizes Education. The hood for the Masters candidates is essentially the same as the Bachelor hood, except that the trim is usually an inch or two wider. All the Bachelor level hoods are lined with satin in the colours of the university granting the degree. Hence at Saint Mary's the hood is lined with maroon satin with a white chevron. The Masters hood at Saint Mary's is lined with maroon satin only to give it added distinction from the Bachelor's.

Distinctions on Degrees and Diplomas

At Saint Mary's University in the general undergraduate degree and diploma programme, academic distinctions are awarded to successful candidates on the basis of the following quality point averages calculated on the highest grades attained in twelve courses taken at Saint Mary's, including the last ten in the student's programme in the case of the pass degree and, in the case of honors, seventeen courses (or equivalent) including the last fifteen courses in a student's degree programme. In the case of the Diploma in Engineering, the best ten courses are selected. There are no distinctions awarded in the Bachelor of Education programme, nor in graduate and certificate programmes.

History of Saint Mary's University

Saint Mary's University was founded in 1802 to provide opportunities for higher learning to young Catholic men. Its founder, the Reverend Edmund Burke, had meagre resources to work with but, on later being named Bishop with responsibility for Nova Scotia, he continued to support the college as essential to the development of the Catholic community. In 1841, the Nova Scotia House of Assembly gave formal recognition of its academic role. Its legal status was confirmed in perpetuity by enactment in 1852.

In 1913, the Christian Brothers of Ireland, a teaching order, were invited by the Archdiocese of Halifax to direct the college and its academic program. During the ensuing years, Saint Mary's University became more widely known for the quality of its undergraduate teaching and continued to develop new instructional programs most notably within its Faculty of Commerce. In 1940, the Upper Canada Province of The Society of Jesus was invited to succeed the Christian Brothers as administrators and teachers in the University, and for thirty years until the enactment in 1970 of the new act of incorporation, the college remained under Jesuit supervision. The long-standing emphasis on liberal arts and commerce was extended to include new programs in science, engineering, and teacher education. Extension courses became an important part of the University's commitment to an active educational role in the community.

The Ceremonial Mace

The ceremonial mace, which is carried by the Marshal of Convocation at the head of the academic procession, was presented to Saint Mary's in April, 1980 and used for the first time at the 1980 Convocation. It symbolizes the University's authority to grant degrees. It was made and presented to the University by Maritime Command in recognition of Saint Mary's alumni killed

in both world wars and also serving members of the Canadian Armed Forces who have been students at the University.

The mace is made of oak with a cast brass crown and brass plates carrying traditional ceremonial engravings. The plates represent the contribution to Saint Mary's by the Jesuit Fathers, the Christian Brothers of Ireland, the Archdiocese of Halifax, the LaSalle Christian Brothers, the Lay Teachers, and the Armed Forces.

Flags on the Stage

Each year Saint Mary's has a number of non-Canadians in its student body. The flags which you see displayed on the stage for Convocation are from some of the countries from which these students come, not necessarily graduating students, but those in any year of study. This international aspect of the Saint Mary's University community is a feature of justifiable pride which contributes markedly to the growth and understanding of both Canadian and non-Canadian students. Also included in the University's permanent collection of flags is one from the International Year of the Disabled signifying the University's commitment to disabled people.

University Crest

The University crest was designed in the 1940s by the Reverend Daniel Fogarty, S.J. Each symbol in the crest has a significance relevant to the various phases and history of the University.

On the outer portion of the crest the name and location of the University are inscribed in Latin, and, in Roman numerals (1841), the date the University received its charter authorizing it to grant degrees.

The book shown above the shield represents learning and knowledge. The inscription on the page of the book is in Latin – "Age Quod Agis". This is the motto of the University which exhorts all those connected with the University to strive to do their best in everything that they do. This quotation is from the Irish Christian Brothers and symbolizes their contribution to the development of the institution.

The upper part of the shield has the official seal of the Jesuits with I.H.S. being the Latin initials for Christ's name. Below these initials are the three nails which represent the Crucifixion and surrounding these is the Crown of Thorns.

The two crowns represent a dual loyalty - to the then Dominion of Canada and to the British Commonwealth. Below these crowns is the thistle, which stands for Nova Scotia's Scottish heritage.

Graduation-Alumni Pins

The Alumni Association of Saint Mary's University has generously provided an Alumni Pin to each member of the Spring Class of 1992. Graduates are encouraged to wear theirs with pride and to consider becoming an active member of the Association.
