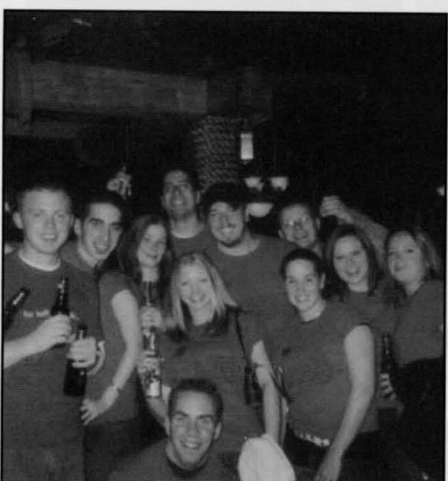


# Criminology Society

The society seeks to promote unity among Caribbean Students, and to expose other students and individuals to Caribbean Culture. For the 2004-2005 school year, the society's executive board consisted of Nikisha Walter (President), Francisco Neily (Vice President), Esaura Roker (Secretary), Chervahun Emilien (Treasurer), Simone Saunders (Public Relations Officer), and Camarsha Samuel (SMU Caribanza Coordinator). The Society is one of the largest on campus with 150 registered members.



This school year the society planned at least 10 events which consisted of parties, a barbecue and fun day, a luncheon, involvement in the first ever Multicultural Festival put on by the IDS Society, participating in International night, Caribanza (which is a combined effort by SMU, DAL and the Mounts Caribbean Societies). The Society launched its first ever SMU Caribbean Culture and Talent Expo: "In word and song", in the first semester. This was held in the Art Gallery and featured a variety of cultural performances from the Caribbean, Bahamas, Canada, Egypt, and Mexico. For the Saint Mary's University Women's Hockey team, the 2004-2005 season began with 9 new faces in the line-up, and 11 returning veterans. The year began with a trip to Toronto for the Marion Hillard Memorial tournament. The Huskies started things off with huge victory over U of Ottawa, the 2004 CIS Silver Medallists, and continued their hot streak by beating former CIS National Champions, the Uof Toronto Blues. This secured a spot in the Championship final for the Huskies, where they came within a goal of the UBC Thunderbirds, losing the game 6-5.

The huskies entered the regular season facing a very challenging schedule, where they would be facing their 2 biggest rivals, the SFX X-Women, and Dalhousie Tigers a total of 10 times. The season turned out to be a very big success for such a young Huskies squad, as they finished tied for 1<sup>st</sup> overall with the X-Women, posting a 15-3 record, losing only to the X-women 3 of 5 times. That set up an AUS semi-final game with the host Dalhousie Tigers. Although the Huskies had locked up 6 consecutive victories over the Tigers this season, having to face them on Tiger territory to get to the AUS Championship game, would prove much more difficult than any game in the teams' history against each other. The Huskies were trailing 1-0 heading into the 3<sup>rd</sup> period, when rookie Courtney Schriver scored to tie the game with the clock winding down. Nothing was solved in regulation and the two teams were forced into a sudden-victory overtime. Once again, Schriver potted the winner by hammering home a rebound off the shot by Lindsay Taylor, giving the Huskies an exciting and dramatic 2-1 OT victory, and sending them to the AUS Championship game for the 7<sup>th</sup> time in 8 years.

Unfortunately, the Tigers took too much out of the Huskies and there was not enough left in the tank to tackle the X-Women in the final. The Huskies had to endure a very frustrating 8-3 loss to the X-Women, and were unable to defend their AUS Championship banner for a 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive year.

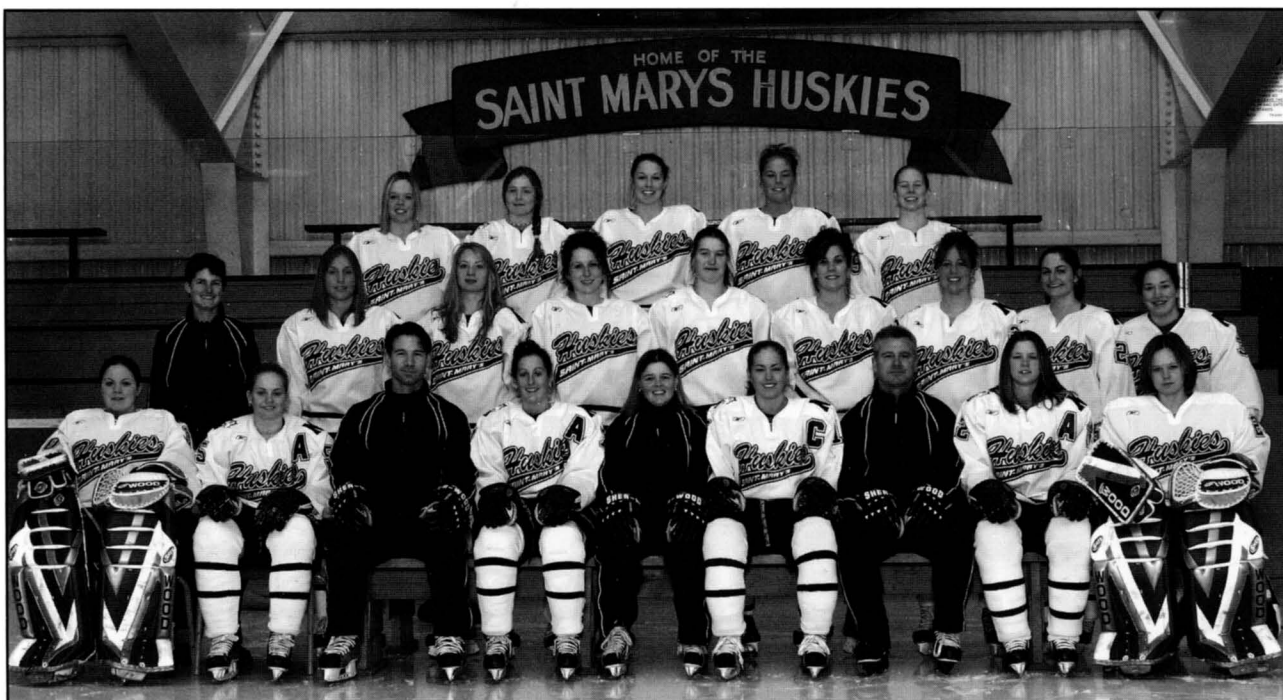

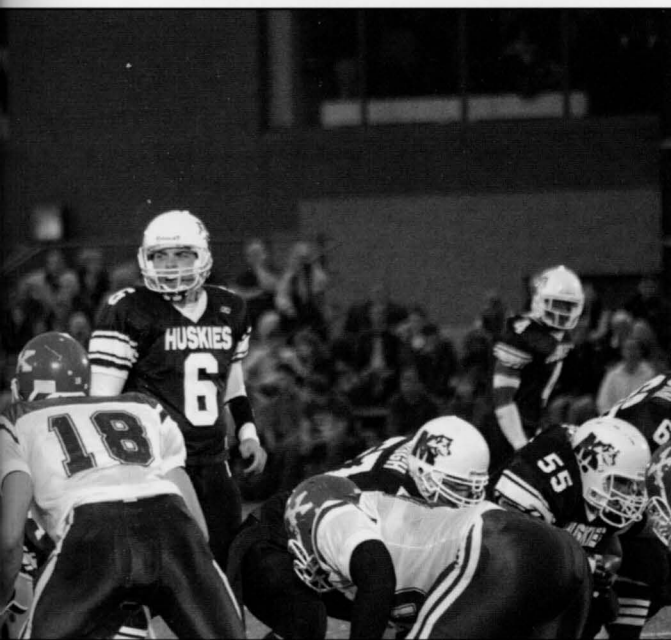
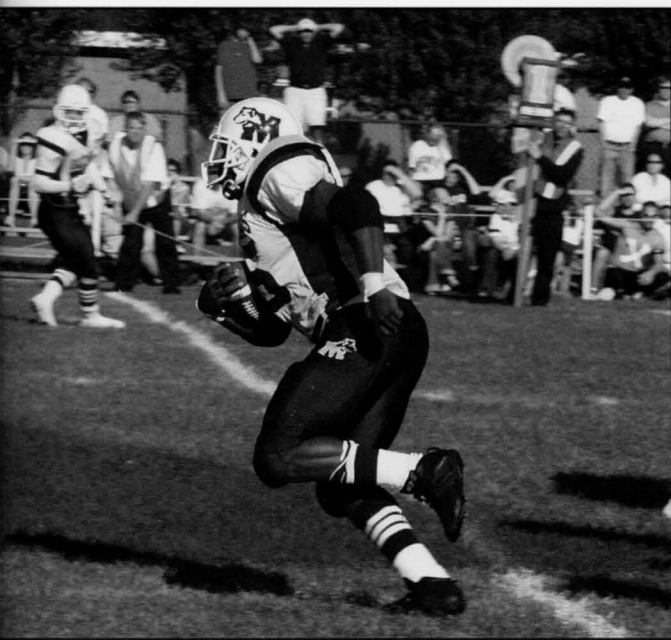
While graduation is relatively light this year look for sensations Les Mullings, Sebastian Clovis, and Tim MacDonald to move into possible professional opportunities.

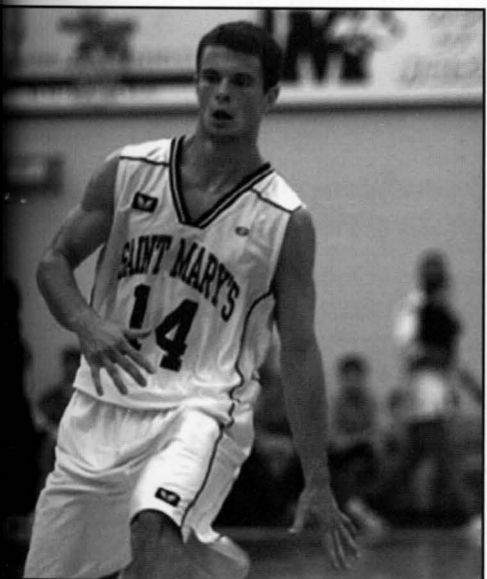
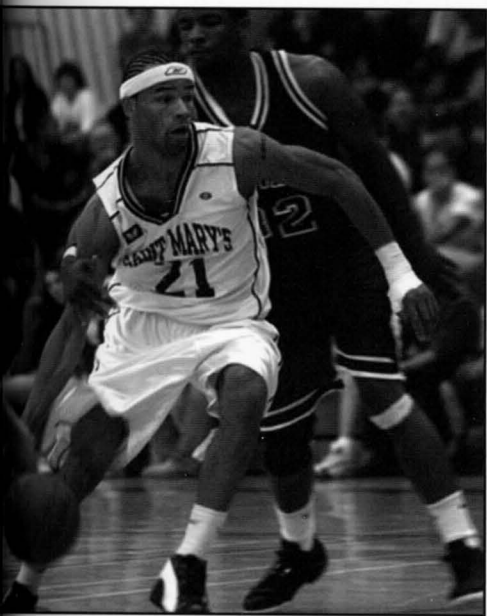
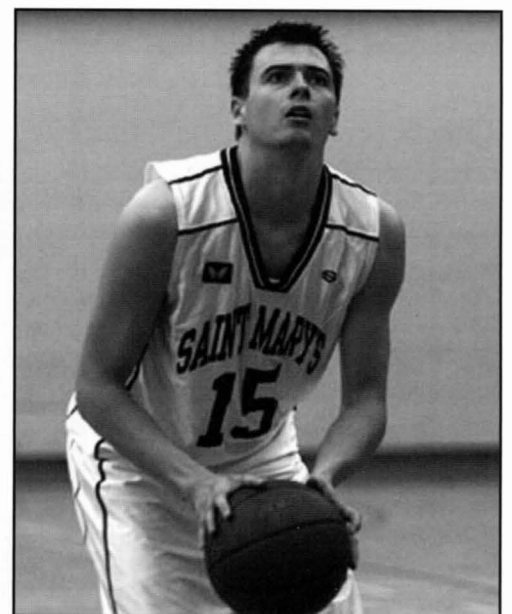
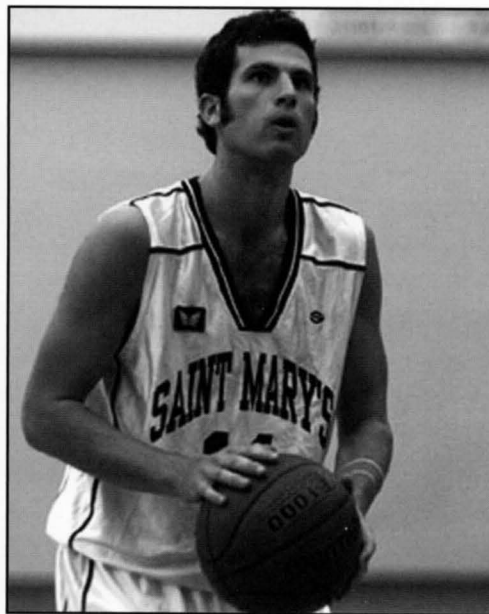
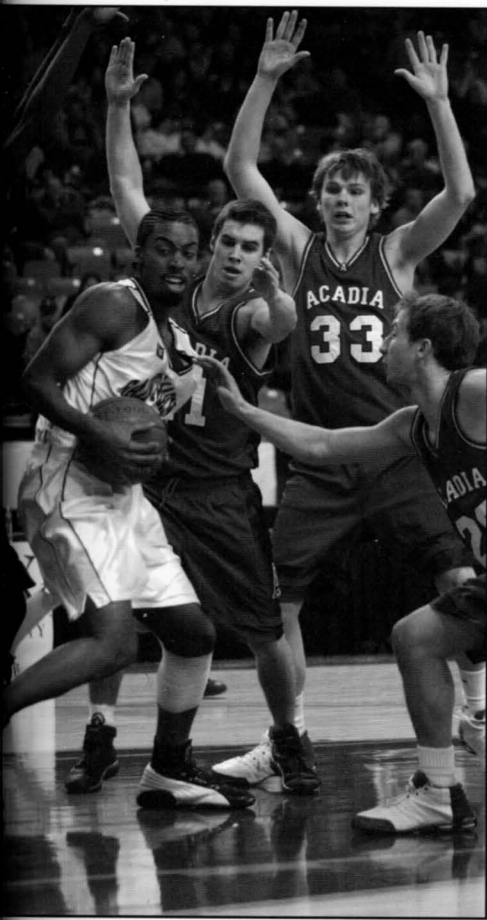
The men's basketball Huskies entered this year's Final Ten as the AUS Finalists. As the 3<sup>rd</sup> seeded team the Huskies beat the 6<sup>th</sup> seeded Acadia Axemen 66-60 and the 2<sup>nd</sup> seeded Cape Breton University Capers 58-54 before losing to St.FX by a score of 82-72 in the AUS Championship final game. Led by All-Stars Jerome Goodman and Nelson Carvery this year's squad could be best characterized as a scrappy defensive team, holding their opponents to an average of only 67.9ppg. Offensively they relied primarily to Goodman (17.5ppg, 9.1rpg) in the low post and guards Carvery (15.2ppg, 4.5rpg) and Jonathan Thibault (12.4ppg, 3.3rpg) on the perimeter. Other key players included point guard Damon Cole, point guard Mark Ross, power forwards Morgan Gallagher and Damian Gay.

Winning their opening game again Waterloo, the Huskies lost their next two games and finished 8<sup>th</sup> in the Final Ten Tournament. The Huskies will be back and strong again next year only losing two players to graduation.

The 2004-05 season has been an exciting one for the Saint Mary's Huskies and their fans, highlighted by another trip to the AUS championships. The Huskies had a grueling first half playing only 1 home game. The team traveled to Quebec City where they played nationally ranked Laval and had a great time at the Laval/SMU football game. Two weeks later they traveled to Waterloo to participate in the James Naismith tournament and enjoyed a great victory over the University of Western. The Huskies first six conference games featured a lot more travel as the team went to UNB, UPEI, St. Francis Xavier, and Memorial all in the span of three weeks. Although the travel was extensive it served to unite the Huskies and develop a tough, team centered attitude that would carry them through the many challenges the season would present.

After Christmas the Huskies hosted their annual Huskies Holiday Invitational. Once again the tournament was a great success and featured a final of two nationally ranked powerhouses Winnipeg and Laval. Once conference play began the team battled through a lot of diversions and injuries to win several big games in January and February. The Huskies came out on the short end of some extremely close games including a last second loss to Memorial but never gave up and kept fighting. Heading into playoffs the team is very confident that they have what it takes to win the AUS championship and be headed to Winnipeg for the CIS championship.

The Huskies were led by the steady play of 4<sup>th</sup> year post Laura MacPherson all season. MacPherson averaged 14 points and 8 rebounds a game while shooting a blistering 54 percent. Dynamic 4<sup>th</sup> year forward Jamie Walker provided another stellar year of outstanding defensive play and versatile offense which saw her average 11 points a game. 5<sup>th</sup> year guard Sam Coutts proved to be one of the best point guards in the conference, sparking her team with an incredible work ethic and averaging 5 rebounds and 3 steals a game. AUS rookie of the year candidate Alise Brown gave Huskies fans a glimpse of things to come with an excellent rookie campaign, averaging 9.5 points a game and started nearly every game in her first season of AUS play.

The Huskies capped off their season by finishing in the top four of the AUS. The Championship tournament was hosted by UNB, home of the 2006 CIS National Championship. The Huskies once again met their cross town rivals Dalhousie Tigers in the quarter final. The Tigers had beaten the Huskies in all four league outings, but as in the 2004 championship the Huskies played one of their best games all season upsetting the heavily favored Tiger team 65-62. Graduating senior Jamie Walker played an outstanding game dominating both ends of the court. Jamie scored an exciting 24 points, while holding AUS All Star Ryan McKay to 10 points. Laura MacPherson also dominated in the post with 17 points and 11 rebounds. Heather Rudderham finished her university career scoring three key three pointers in the second half to put the Huskies up by as much as 11 points.

The key to the Huskies attack this season was their depth, with all 12 players contributing nearly every game. With a nucleus of up and coming players like Alise Brown, 2<sup>nd</sup> year forward Venessa Ryan, and 1<sup>st</sup> year post Ashley Briggs, the Huskies future looks very bright. The team will have big shoes to fill with the graduation of five seniors including MacPherson - Bachelor of Commerce, Walker - Bachelor Arts, and Sam Coutts, Heather Rudderham - Catherine Steiner all completing their careers with a Bachelor of Science degree.

# Women's Volleyball

The 2004-2005 season was a year of development and success. The Huskies started the year as the defending AUS champions, but were technically rebuilding with only five players returning from that team. This group was supported by a strong recruiting class that brought height, speed, power, and youth to the program. It was a busy year, which included exhibition matches in every conference in the country – Saskatoon, Montreal, and here at home in October, and Ottawa in January. It was a time that built experience quickly and toughened the young in preparation for a run at defending the banner.

Players grew close and supportive, and the rigorous schedule (20 league matches) provided ample opportunity to develop prior to playoffs. The Huskies met their pre-season goal of finishing in the top 2 in the standings for league play and earned a bye in the first round of the playoffs. They came out very strong against Acadia in the semi-finals, playing nearly flawlessly and winning three straight sets. The team felt confident going into the final, but ran into a much older and more experienced team in Dalhousie that played its best match of the year. It was a difficult way to finish the season but at the same time the experience will serve the many returning players well next season.

The Huskies were led all year by 4<sup>th</sup> year setter Pam Rogers and 5<sup>th</sup> year middle Caroline MacFarlane. Both were in their final season with the team and provided invaluable leadership and guidance to their teammates, all of whom were 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year and 20 years old or younger. The generation gap made for a unique experience for all involved, as the youth on the team had the distinct advantage of learning from two of the best players in the league. Pam was again chosen as an All-Star and was the top-ranked setter and Caroline was a conference All-Star and a CIS All-Canadian. Pam was awarded the President's Award by the Athletics Department and both players achieved Academic All-Canadian status. Huskies Volleyball has been extremely proud of them and their accomplishments.

The Huskies were also fortunate to have Linda Fuhrmann, an exchange student from Germany, here for one year. She is an outstanding athlete and was essential as the team's libero. She will be returning to Germany to finish school. Second year players Tara Matheson, Alex Quinn, Steph Scollan, and Danielle Shortall played large roles and grew as players based on their rookie experiences from last year. These four will be well prepared to step into leadership roles in the absence of Pam and Caroline next year. First year players Janesse Boudreau, Kristen McCulloch, Lianne Wilson, and Emily Winfield all showed steady progress in their development. Janesse and Kristen established themselves as capable and influential players on the left side despite their young ages. Lianne persevered through injuries to make great gains and will undoubtedly have a major impact on the team's success next season.

The youth and sustainability of the team is exciting, and the right mix of incoming talent to backfill for the graduating players will ensure good opportunities and lofty goals for next year's team. Players and coaches alike are eagerly looking forward to returning to action.

Many thanks go to Darren Russell in his third year as assistant coach with the Huskies. A very strong coach in his own right, the team is very fortunate to have his services. He is extremely dedicated and insightful, and the team's success is largely attributed to his efforts. His return next season will ensure the trend continues.

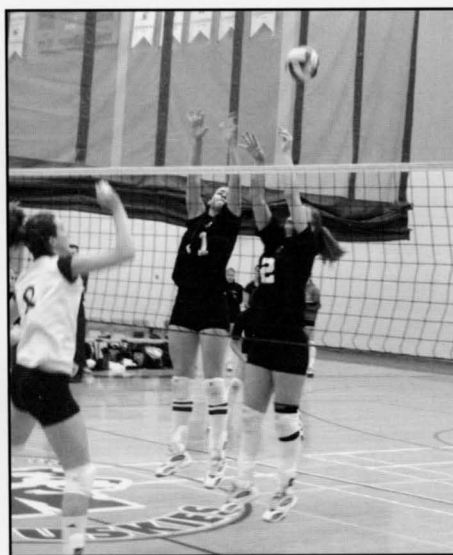
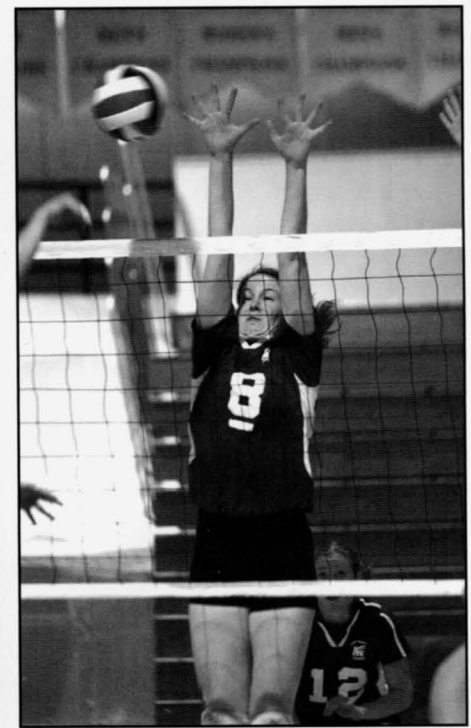

# Men's & Women's Cross Country

The 2004 women's cross country team completed their most successful year to date at the AUS level. Senior, Tiffany Larder had a tremendous season in recording four top ten finishes in regular season meets and placed eleventh at the AUS Championships. The men's team finished in 5<sup>th</sup> place at the AUS Championships.

At the CIS Championships in Guelph, Kenny finished in 74<sup>th</sup> place in a personal best time of 34:20 for 10km.



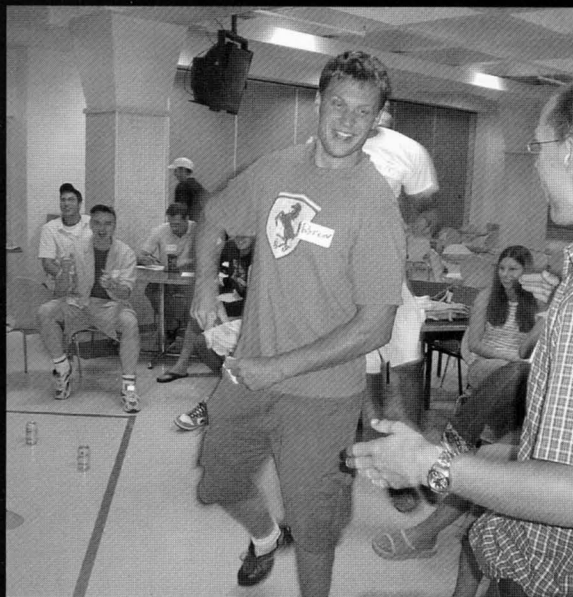
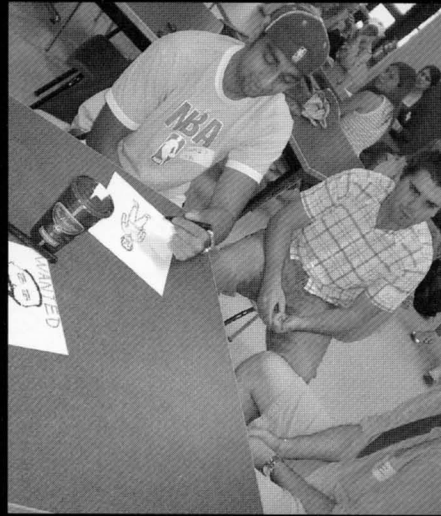

# Gorsebrook Lounge

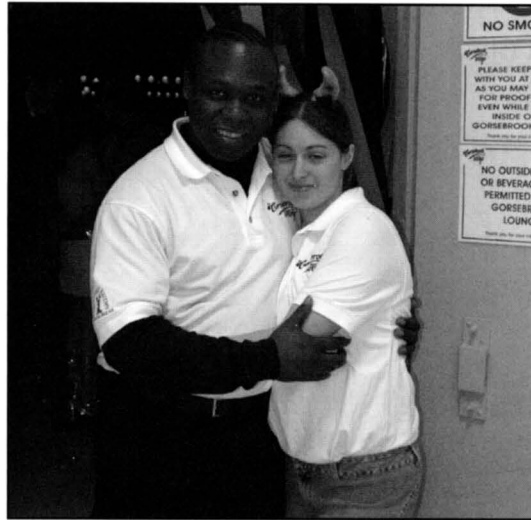

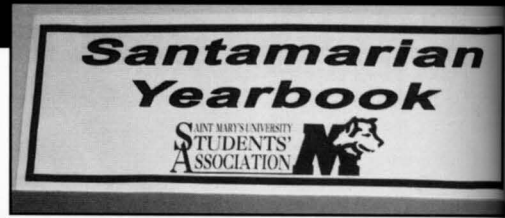
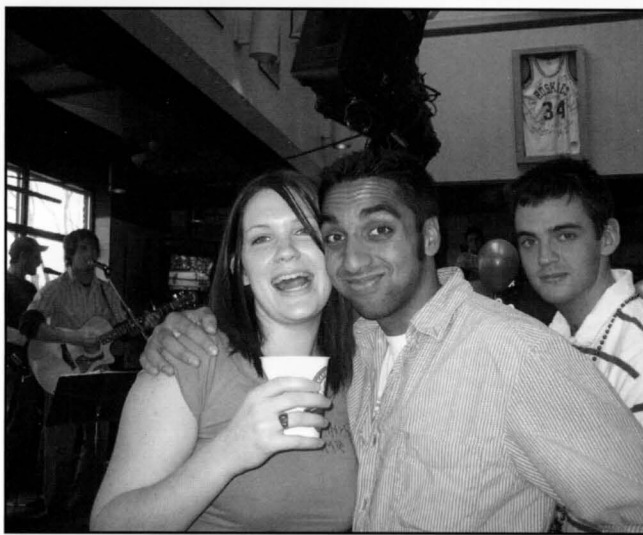
# FUNCTIONS

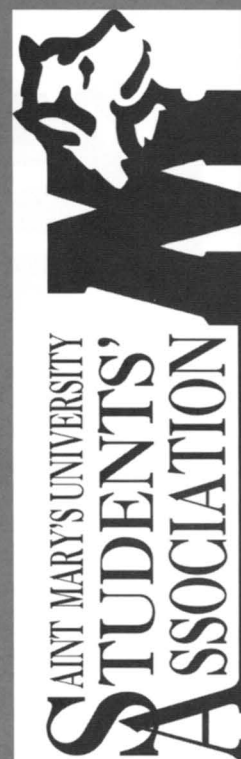

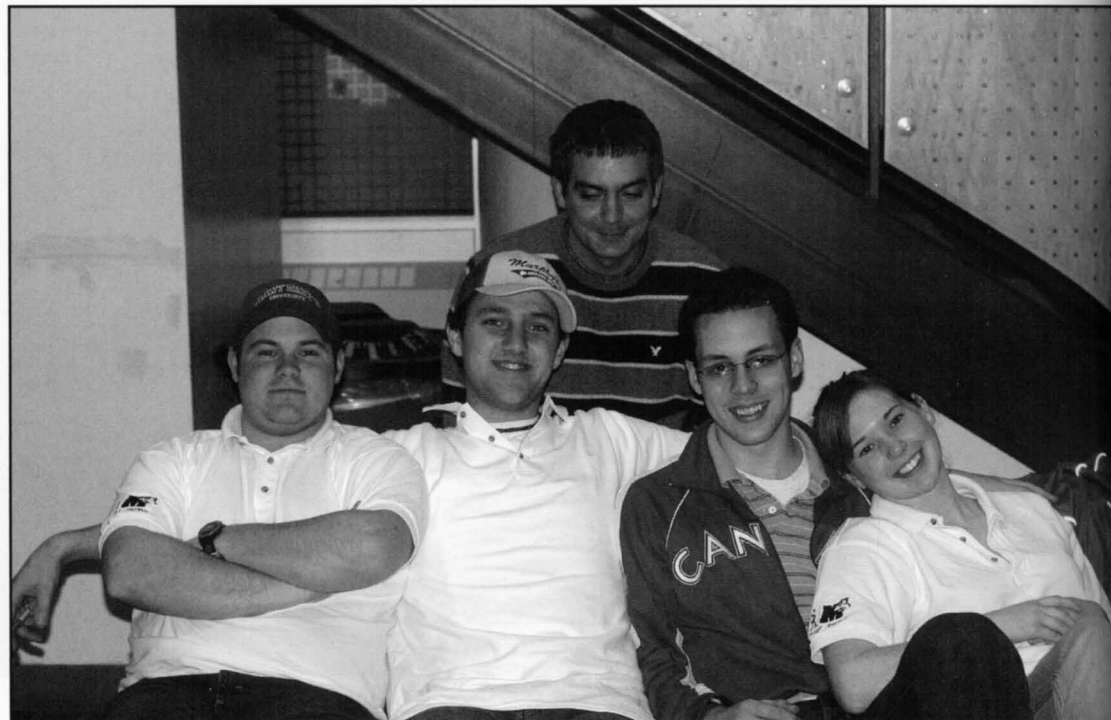
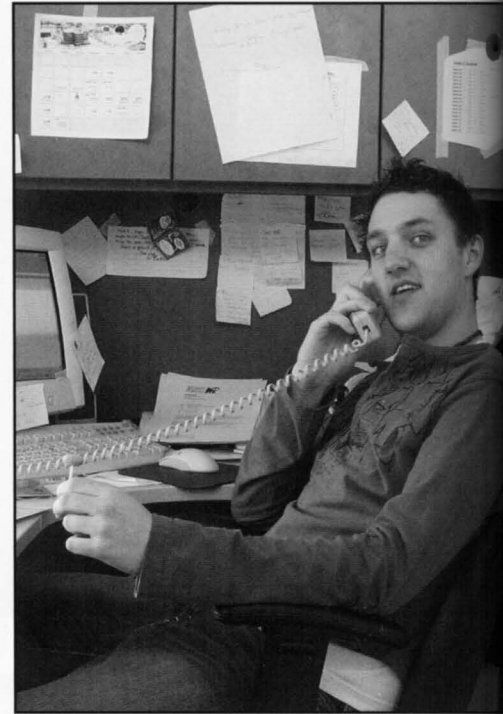


# Husky Patrol
