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DEFINITIONS

1. Full-Time Students (FTS)

A full-time student is one who is enrolled in three or more courses in one semester.

2. Part-Time Students (PTS)

A part-time student is one who is enrolled in less than three courses in one semester.

3. Special Student (SPE)

A student, working towards a degree at another academic institution, who has a letter of permission to take a course or courses at Saint Mary's University.

4. UPGRADING STUDENT (UPG)

A student who already holds an undergraduate degree or professional certificate and who wishes to take additional credit courses at Saint Mary's University.

5. NON-DEGREE PROGRAMME STUDENT (NDP)

A status permitting a student to take a course or courses although that individual has not been accepted in a degree programme at Saint Mary's University.

6. Course Registration

One student enrolled in one-full course.
